**Nov. 10, 1999** - Reported to the House by the House Committee on Rules and placed on the House Calendar by unanimous consent. HRpt 106-465 (Congressional Record p. H11952)

**Nov. 10, 1999** - Committee consideration and markup session held by the House Rules Committee. (Congressional Record p. D1295)

**Nov. 10, 1999** - \*\* COMMITTEE VOTE \*\* HRES374. Suspension of Rules/Two-Hour Notice. Moakley, D-Mass., amendment that would require leadership to notify members two hours before considering legislation on the floor under a suspension of the rules. Rejected 4-9; R 0-9; D 4-0, November 10, 1999. (Congressional Record p. D1295)

**Nov. 10, 1999** - \*\* COMMITTEE VOTE \*\* HRES374. Suspension of Rules/Motion to Report. Goss, R-Fla., motion to report the resolution that would allow at any time on or before the legislative day of Nov. 17, 1999, for the speaker of the House to entertain motions to suspend the rules, provided that the object of any such motion is announced from the floor at least one hour before the motion is offered and that the minority leader is consulted. Reported favorably for consideration of the House by voice vote November 10, 1999. (Congressional Record p. D1295)
