**INFORMATION
18 U.S.C. § 1001**

The United States of America charges:


1. In 2007 and 2008, WILLIAM T. ARMSTRONG ("the defendant") was employed as the Chief of the Construction Division at the Fort Carson Directorate of Contracting (a unit of the U.S. Army Contracting Agency, an agency within the executive branch of the United States), which is located in the State and District of Colorado.

2. By virtue of his position, the defendant was required to submit every year a Confidential Financial Disclosure Report with the Army Contracting Agency. The report requires, among other things, a certification stating whether or not the defendant received reportable gifts in the prior year. In or about May 2007, the defendant received reportable gifts valued at \$3,378.12.


3. On or about January 24, 2008, in the State and District of Colorado, the defendant, in a matter within the jurisdiction of the executive branch of the Government of the United

States, knowingly and willfully made and used a false document, namely a Confidential Financial Disclosure Report, knowing the same to contain a materially false, fictitious and fraudulent statement and entry: that the defendant had not received any reportable gifts.

The foregoing was a violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1001(a)(3).




