Re: ReView Grant Money

As you are aware, in 2000 I raised almost \$1,000,000 from the drug industry for the purpose of getting results with our "one extra script per patient (ReView) program".

If there was a bonafide expense associated with ReView, I asked Tom Marsh to expense from the ReView grant money and not my department budget. I was very frugal in using this pool of money as we still have a balance of over \$925,000! Every payment I authorized was for something we were going to do anyway, or had your explicit approval.

This year I am requesting even more money for the same purpose, and I believe we will get about \$1.1 million in additional funds. This will give us a "war chest" of over \$2,000,000 to advance our ReView program.

Tom Marsh recently informed me that I am not authorized to expense ANY money from the ReView Grant money.

Joel, please give me advice on how to get the results you want. Some pharmacies need training, some may need other forms of help to accomplish our goal.

Is it possible for me to have some pre-approved amount, that you authorize, so I can stimulate some positive results on ReView?
