Relevant Chadian Legal Provisions

Law N° 004/PR/2000

**On Suppressing Misappropriation of Public Property, Corruption,
Embezzlement, Influence Peddling, and Related Offenses**

Considering the Constitution;

The National Assembly deliberated and adopted at its session of January 25, 2000;

The President of the Republic has enacted the following law:

TITLE II

**ON CORRUPTION, DAMAGE SUFFERED, EMBEZZLEMENT AND INFLUENCE
PEDDLING**

Chapter 3

On Influence Peddling

Article 13.- Anyone who through assault, threats, gifts or promises corrupts a person, having a real or presumed influence for the purpose of obtaining any advantage from public authorities is punishable by two (2) years in prison and a fine of two hundred thousand (200,000) to five million (5,000,000) francs.

Article 14.- The official who, for his own or for someone else's account, solicits, agrees or receives offers, promises or gifts for the purpose of obtaining any advantage granted by public authorities or by an organism overseen by public authorities, business deals or any other benefits resulting from agreements concluded with public authorities, abusing in this manner the real or alleged influence bestowed by his capacity or mandate, shall be punishable by the same sanctions.
