PROPOSED DECISION

MARVEL, CHAIRMAN. This claim seeks the recovery of two thousand dinars or ten dollars, alleged to have been taken by the Yugoslav Government on August 15, 1950.

The claim is before this Commission upon the proceeding of the Solicitor of the Commission pursuant to Section 300.16 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Commission.

The Yugoslav Claims Agreement of 1948 applies only to the taking by Yugoslavia of property which occurred between September 1, 1939 and July 19, 1948. This taking, not having occurred within this period, the claimant is not entitled to receive compensation under the Yugoslav Claims Agreement of 1948 or the International Claims Settlement Act of 1949.

The claim is denied in whole.
