PROPOSED DECISION

This is a claim against the Government of Czechoslovakia under the provisions of Section 404 of Title IV of the International Claims Settlement Act of 1949, as amended.

Section 411 of the aforesaid Act provides that the Commission "shall give public notice by publication in the Federal Register of the time when, and the limit of time within which claims may be filed, which limit shall not be more than twelve months after such publication."

Pursuant to the Congressional mandate, the Commission published in the Federal Register of September 16, 1958, public notice that claims against the Government of Czechoslovakia under Title IV of the Act shall be filed with the Commission on or before August 1, 1959. Subsequently, the Commission extended the time for filing claims against the Government of Czechoslovakia under Title IV of the Act by publishing notice in the Federal Register on July 24, 1959 that

claims shall be filed with the Commission on or before September 15, 1959, the terminal date of the aforementioned twelve-month period prescribed by statute.


The record in this claim discloses that it was filed by mail bearing the postmark date of September 16, 1959.
