PROPOSED DECISION

These are claims against the Government of Hungary under Section 303(2) of the International Claims Settlement Act of 1949, as amended, for \$14,491.40 and for \$7,649.48, by STEVEN M. ROSTAS and EDITH ROSTAS, nationals of the United States since their naturalization in the United States on November 8, 1946, for nationalization of property in Hungary.

The Commission finds that the claimants were the owners in equal shares of an apartment house at 6 Szitakoto Street, Budapest, Hungary, and that claimant EDITH ROSTAS was the sole owner of a one-family dwelling house at 4 Szigligeti Street, Budapest, Hungary, both of which were nationalized without compensation by the Government of Hungary pursuant to Hungarian Law-Decree 1952:4 tvr. (Official Gazette No. 18, February 17, 1952). The Commission further finds that the value of the property at 6 Szitakoto Street (Claim No. HUNG-20,092) was eleven thousand eight hundred fifty-two dollars and seventy-six cents (\$11,852.76) and that the value of the property at 4 Szigligeti Street (Claim No. HUNG-20,093) was four thousand eight hundred eighty-three dollars and five cents (\$4,883.05); and concludes that claimants are entitled to awards under Section 303(2) of the Act.

A W A R D S

Pursuant to the provisions of the International Claims Settlement Act of 1949, as amended, an award is hereby made to STEVEN M. ROSTAS in the amount of five thousand nine hundred twenty-six dollars and thirty-eight cents (\$5,926.38) plus interest thereon at the rate of 6% per annum from February 17, 1952 to August 9, 1955, the effective date of the Act, in the amount of one thousand two hundred thirty-seven dollars and sixty-one cents (\$1,237.61);

and an award is made to EDITH ROSTAS in the amount of ten thousand eight hundred nine dollars and forty-three cents (\$10,809.43) plus interest thereon at the rate of 6% per annum from February 17, 1952 to August 9, 1955, the effective date of the Act, in the amount of two thousand two hundred fifty-seven dollars and thirty-three cents (\$2,257.33).

Payment of any part of these awards shall not be construed to have divested the claimants herein, or the Government of the United States, on their behalf, of any rights against the Government of Hungary for the unpaid balance of the claim, if any.
