PROPOSED DECISION

This timely filed claim for \$14,550.00 is before the Commission by virtue of an amendment to Section 304 of the International Claims Settlement Act of 1949, as amended, pursuant to Section 2, Public Law 85-604.

The claim is deemed eligible for consideration for reasons set forth in the decision issued with respect to the claim of Petes Allen (Claim No. IT-10,640, Decision No. IT-81-2), a copy of which is attached.

The record discloses that the claimant ANTONIA J. POULOS, is a citizen of the United States since her naturalization on November 11, 1954. The record further discloses that the claimant was the owner of certain personal property and a 2 story 20 room building located at Getheo, Lakonia, Greece and damage to land located at Limbro, Lakonia, Greece and that said property was lost, damaged or destroyed as a result of a series of Italian actions, deemed to have begun on or about April 22, 1941. The claimant seeks further compensation for the loss of rent. This portion of the claim must be and hereby is denied for the reason that the Commission has repeatedly held that rentals are speculative in character and are not compensable

Claimant's damages are determined to be \$5,000.00.


A W A R D

It is therefore ORDERED that said claim be and the same is hereby allowed and an award made to ANTONIA J. POULOS in the sum of \$5,000.00, together with interest in the amount of \$2,100.00, being 6 percent per annum from April 22, 1941 to April 23, 1948, the date of payment by the Government of Italy of \$5,000,000 pursuant to the Memorandum of Understanding dated August 14, 1947, PROVIDED that no payment shall be made with respect to this award until payment in full, from the Italian Claims Fund created pursuant to Section 302, of the principal amounts (without interest) of all awards upon claims determined under the original provisions of Section 304.
