PROPOSED DECISION OF THE COMMISSION

This claim arose out of the loss sustained by the claimant as the owner of real property presently located within the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics and allegedly taken by that Government.


Section 305(a)(2) of the International Claims Settlement Act of 1949,^{1/} as amended by Public Law 285, 84th Congress, approved August 9, 1955,^{2/} provides for the receipt and determination by the Commission of the validity and amounts of claims of nationals of the United States against the Soviet Government, provided such claims arose prior to November 16, 1933.

Inasmuch as the territory in which the real property is located was formerly a part of Czechoslovakia which was ceded to the U. S. S. R. on June 29, 1945, the Commission finds that this claim arose subsequent to November 16, 1933, and is, therefore, denied. Other elements bearing upon eligibility and entitlement have not been considered.
