FINAL DECISION

This is a claim against the Government of Bulgaria under Section 303(1) of the International Claims Settlement Act of 1949, as amended, for \$104.10 by HOWARD CONRAD LIEBL, a national of the United States since his birth in the United States on November 30, 1917, for loss of property in Bulgaria during World War II.

In a decision issued on March 26, 1958, the denial of the claim was proposed. Upon reconsideration, the Commission finds that the claimant was the owner of certain personal property which was lost in Bulgaria as a result of World War II and that this claim falls within the scope of Section 303(1) of the Act. The Commission further finds that the loss or damage actually sustained amounted to One Hundred Four Dollars and Ten Cents (\$104.10), and concludes that claimant is entitled to an award under Section 303(1) of the Act for two-thirds of that amount, since under this Section awards are limited to two-thirds of the loss or damage actually sustained.

PROPOSED DECISION

This is a claim against the Government of Bulgaria under the provisions of Section 303 of the International Claims Settlement Act of 1949, as amended, for the loss of certain personal property valued at one hundred four dollars and ten cents (\$104.10), allegedly taken from the person of the claimant, then a member of the Armed Forces of the United States, following a parachute landing in Bulgarian territory and capture by Bulgarian authorities during World War II.

For the reasons specified by the majority of the Commission in the attached copy of Proposed Decision No. RUM-344, In the Matter of the Claim of James Allen Brittain (RUM-30,012), this claim is denied.
