AGREED FINAL JUDGMENT OF PERMANENT INJUNCTION

The United States of America has filed a complaint for permanent injunction in this matter against the defendant, Andrew DeDominicis, also known as Andrew D. Brown, individually and doing business as Impact Ministries International ("IMI"). DeDominicis hereby consents to the entry of this Agreed Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction.

DeDominicis enters into this Agreed Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction voluntarily, and waives the entry of findings of fact and conclusions of law. DeDominicis also waives any right he may have to appeal this Agreed Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction. All parties agree that entry of this injunction neither precludes the Internal Revenue Service from assessing penalties against DeDominicis for asserted violations of the Internal Revenue Code nor precludes DeDominicis from contesting any such penalties. DeDominicis agrees that the Court shall retain jurisdiction over him for the purpose of implementing and enforcing this injunction.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is accordingly ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that:

1. Andrew DeDominicis, also known as Andrew D. Brown, individually and doing business as any entity, and his representatives, agents, servants, employees, attorneys, and those

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persons in active concert or participation with him, is permanently enjoined from, directly or indirectly:

- (a) Organizing, promoting, marketing, selling, or advising with respect to any plan or arrangement, including the corporation sole scheme described in the complaint or any other scheme that assists or advises customers to attempt to violate the internal revenue laws or unlawfully evade the assessment or collection of their federal tax liabilities;
- (b) Engaging in conduct subject to penalty under IRC § 6700, *i.e.*, by making or furnishing, in connection with the organization or sale of a plan or arrangement, a statement about the securing of any tax benefit that the defendant knows or has reason to know to be false or fraudulent as to any material matter under the federal tax laws;
- (c) Engaging in any conduct that interferes with the administration and enforcement of the internal revenue laws; and
- (d) Engaging in any activity subject to penalty under the Internal Revenue Code.

2. DeDominicis, at his own expense and as a corrective measure, is to take the following action and file with the Court a certificate of compliance stating that he has done so within 60 days of entry of this Judgment:

- Provide a copy of this injunction order to each individual or entity who has purchased a corporation sole from DeDominicis and/or IMI; and

- Remove from the web sites www.impactministries-int.net and www.impactministries-int.org, any material promoting the formation or use of the corporation sole and not establish any future website that promotes the formation or use of a corporation sole.

- Take whatever action is necessary to remove IMI and/or Andrew DeDominicis as registered agent for any corporations sole, including, but not limited to, notifying every entity or person who uses or lists IMI and/or Andrew DeDominicis as the registered agent for their corporation sole and informing those persons/entities that DeDominicis and IMI (and any person associated with them) can no longer act as registered agent and instructing those persons/entities to obtain a new registered agent for their corporations sole.

3. The United States shall be permitted to engage in post-judgment discovery to monitor compliance with this injunction order.

4. The Court shall retain jurisdiction over this action for purposes of implementing and enforcing this Final Judgment.
