**ORDER OF RESTITUTION AS TO
DEFENDANT WOODCOCK**

The Court having conducted a restitution hearing and heard evidence on July 29, 2009, and having assessed the defendants ability to pay;

IT IS ORDERED as follows:

That defendant **PAUL WOODCOCK** shall pay restitution in the amount of \$19,402,512 to the victims reflected in Schedule 1, attached hereto, and that the defendant's restitution obligation shall be jointly and severally liable with other defendants in this case until the full restitution is paid. The Court hereby waives the imposition of interest on the restitution amount and any unpaid balances.


That defendant shall pay \$250 per month until incarcerated, \$25 per quarter while incarcerated, \$500 per month starting 120 days after release from incarceration.

That payments shall be made by the defendant to all victims identified in Schedule 1 in proportion to the amount of each victim's loss.

Criminal monetary penalties shall be made payable to the Clerk of U.S. District Court, Attention: Finance, Suite 130, 401 West Washington Street, SPC 1, Phoenix, Arizona 85003-2118. That while incarcerated, payment of criminal monetary penalties are due during

1 imprisonment at a rate of not less than \$25 per quarter and payment shall be made through the
2 Bureau of Prisons' Inmate Financial Responsibility Program. Payments of monetary penalties
3 should be credited in the priority established under 18 U.S.C. Sec. 3612(c).
