SCHEDULING ORDER

The Court has reviewed the Proposed Scheduling Order and has heard the parties' arguments regarding the complexity of the matter.^{1/} Accordingly, and for good cause shown,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED setting the following case management schedule:

- 1. Government Obligations
 - a. Compliance with Rule 16 discovery^{2/} December 16, 2011
 - b. Rule 404(b) notification, if any March 9, 2012
 - c. Initial expert disclosures March 9, 2012

^{1/} At this stage, the government estimates that its case will consume approximately 3-4 trial weeks, assuming trial is held four days per week. The defense estimates their case will take approximately 3-4 trial days. Overall, the combined estimate is 4-5 trial weeks.

^{2/} This category pertains to discovery within the government's possession and control as of the date set for compliance. If additional records are discovered, created, or disclosed during pretrial preparation or otherwise, pursuant to Rule 16(c), Fed. R. Crim. P., the government shall promptly disclose any additional documentary evidence or materials to the defense as soon as practicable after such disclosure, creation, or discovery occurs.

- 1 d. Rebuttal expert disclosures, if any June 29, 2012
- 2 e. Production of Jencks material,
- 3 if not produced sooner ^{3/} December 16, 2011
- 4 2. Close of defendants' discovery
- 5 a. Close of reciprocal Rule 16 discovery September 16, 2012
- 6 b. Rule 404(b) notification, if any September 16, 2012
- 7 c. Rebuttal/initial expert disclosures, if any August 24, 2012
- 8 d. Production of Rule 26.2 material as
- 9 to intended witnesses, if any September 16, 2012
- 10 3. Substantive/procedural motions deadline October 5, 2012
- 11 4. Submission of Juror Questionnaires and
- 12 Joint Statement of the Case November 16, 2012
- 13 5. Joint Proposed Jury Instructions, Joint Proposed
- 14 Verdict Form and Motions in Limine November 16, 2012
- 15 6. Responses to Motions in Limine December 14, 2012
- 16 7. Final Pretrial Conference and
- 17 Rulings on Motions in Limine January 4, 2013
- 18 8. Trial January 29, 2013

19 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the deadline for defendants to enter guilty pleas
20 pursuant to a plea agreement shall be June 8, 2012.
