The Grand Jury charges that:

COUNT 1

On or about April 30, 2013, in Jefferson Parish, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **JOSE MARCO AGUILAR, a/k/a Dani Noriega, a/k/a Romeo C. Perez, a/k/a Otto Rene Sum**, an alien, was found in the United States after having been officially deported and removed therefrom on or about December 29, 2010, and without the Attorney General of the United States or his designated successor, the Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security, as provided for in Title 6, United States Code, Sections 202(3), 202(4), and 557, having expressly consented to the defendant's reapplication for admission into the United States; all in violation of

Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(a).

**NOTICE OF SENTENCING ENHANCEMENT**


Now comes the United States of America, by and through Dana J. Boente, the United States Attorney for the Eastern District of Louisiana, to give notice that on or about October 13, 1993, in the One hundred seventy-fifth District Court of Hidalgo County, Texas, the defendant, **JOSE MARCO AGUILAR, a/k/a Dani Noriega, a/k/a Romeo C. Perez, a/k/a Otto Rene Sum,** was convicted of theft of property with a value of over twenty thousand dollars. Because of this aggravated felony conviction, if the defendant is convicted for a violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(a), the defendant's sentence will be subject to a maximum sentence of imprisonment for not more than 20 years. Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(b)(2).
