FACTUAL BASIS

The defendant, **MICHAEL ROIG**, has agreed to plead guilty to the one count of the information charging him with embezzlement of mail matter by a postal employee, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1709. Both the government and the defendant do hereby stipulate and agree that the following facts set forth a sufficient factual basis for the crime to which the defendant is pleading guilty. The government and the defendant further stipulate that, should this case have gone to trial, the government would have proven, through the introduction of competent testimony and reliable documentary and other evidence, the following facts, beyond a reasonable doubt:

On May 15, 2012, the defendant, **MICHAEL ROIG**, was employed by the United States Postal Service as a letter carrier assigned to the Johnson Street Station located in Jefferson Parish, in the Eastern District of Louisiana. As a letter carrier, the defendant had lawful control of, and was entrusted with, bins of mail awaiting delivery at the Johnson Street Station. In the course of his duties and employment with the Postal Service, the defendant observed a package in one of the aforementioned bins. The package was addressed to “Rouses Supermarket #28, 717 Clearview Pkwy, Attn: Store Manager, Metairie, LA 70001” and contained postal stamps worth approximately \$648.00. The defendant knew from the package’s appearance that it
