The Grand Jury charges that:

COUNT ONE

Between on or about February 17, 2014, and February 27, 2014, in the Eastern District of Louisiana and elsewhere, the defendant, **FRANK MIKE, JR.**, did unlawfully transport in interstate commerce a stolen motor vehicle, that is, a 2010 Dodge Grand Caravan, VIN 2D4RN5D15AR190882 from the State of Louisiana to the State of Georgia, knowing the same to be stolen, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2312.

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE

1) The allegation of Count One of this Indictment is realleged and incorporated by reference as though set forth fully herein for the purpose of alleging forfeiture to the United States of America pursuant to the provisions of Title 18, United States Code, Section 982.

2) As a result of the offense alleged in Count One, the defendant, **FRANK MIKE, JR.**, shall forfeit to the United States pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 982, any and all property, real or personal, which represents or is traceable to the gross proceeds obtained directly or indirectly as a result of the said violation and any and all property used or intended to be used in any manner or part to commit or to facilitate the commission of the violation alleged in Count One of this Indictment.

3) If any of the property subject to forfeiture pursuant to Paragraph 2 of this Notice of Forfeiture, as a result of any acts or omissions of the defendant, **FRANK MIKE, JR.**,

- a.) cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- b.) has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third person;
- c.) has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the Court;
- d.) has been substantially diminished in value; or
- e.) has been commingled with other property which cannot be subdivided without difficulty;

it is the intent of the United States, pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 982(b), to


seek forfeiture of any other property of said defendant up to the value of the above forfeitable property.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 982.


