



4. Because of the nature of our work, the Department of Justice and this office are very cautious about hiring people who currently use or have used illegal drugs. In the past ten years, have you illegally used any controlled substance, for example, marijuana, cocaine, crack cocaine, hashish, narcotics, amphetamines, depressants, hallucinogenics, or prescription drugs? If so, please identify the drug(s), the frequency of your use, and approximately when you most recently used the drug(s).
  
5. Appointment as a Special Assistant U.S. Attorney requires a pre-appointment security clearance. Do you have any objection to a thorough background investigation by the FBI?
  
6. Have you ever been arrested for, charged with, or convicted of any crime? If so, please explain.
  
7. Federal law and Department of Justice policies place some restrictions on a Special Assistant U.S. Attorney's ability to actively participate in any political campaign. Are you willing to abide by this requirement?
  
8. Department of Justice policies place restrictions on a Special Assistant U.S. Attorney's ability to practice law outside of the U.S. Attorney's Office, and prohibits the acceptance of paid compensation for or in anticipation of legal services, while employed by the office. Are you willing to abide by these requirements?
