INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about June 17, 2014, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

ANTHONY ANDREWS,

having been convicted in a court of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, knowingly possessed in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce four firearms and ammunition, that is, an MPA (Masterpiece Arms) 5.7x28 caliber pistol, Model MPA57SST, serial number V8817; an MPA (Masterpiece Arms), Model MPA30T, 9 millimeter pistol, serial number B14351; a CAI (Century Arms International/Zastava Arms) 7.62x39 caliber pistol, Model M92PV, serial number M92PV034868; and a Phoenix Arms, .25 ACP caliber pistol, Model HP25A, serial number 4405278.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(1), 924(e)(1).

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

As a result of the violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1), set forth in this indictment, defendant

ANTHONY ANDREWS

shall forfeit to the United States of America, the firearms and ammunition involved in the commission of this offense, including, but not limited to:

- (1) MPA (Masterpiece Arms) 5.7x28 caliber pistol, Model MPA57SST, serial number V8817;
- (2) MPA (Masterpiece Arms), Model MPA30T, 9 millimeter pistol, serial number B14351;
- (3) CAI (Century Arms International/Zastava Arms) 7.62x39 caliber pistol, Model M92PV, serial number M92PV034868;
- (4) Phoenix Arms, .25 ACP caliber pistol, Model HP25A, serial number 4405278;
- (5) Sixty rounds of 7.62x39 millimeter ammunition;
- (6) Sixty rounds of 5.7x28 millimeter ammunition;
- (7) Nine rounds of .25 caliber ammunition;
- (8) Fifty-four rounds of nine-millimeter ammunition; and
- (9) Thirty-five rounds of .40 caliber ammunition.

All pursuant to Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), and Title 18,
United States Code, Section 924(d).
