INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about April 28, 2012, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

JOEL ERNESTO ESQUERRA-CERVANTES,
a/k/a “Luis Gonzalez-Solivan,”
a/k/a “Raul Salazar-Trujillo,”
a/k/a “Armando Espinoza Padilla”


an alien, and native and citizen of Mexico, who had previously been deported and removed from the United States on or about September 13, 1998, March 3, 1999, February 20, 2000, February 28, 2000, May 13, 2003, September 12, 2003, October 27, 2003, January 13, 2009, January 15, 2009 and January 24, 2009, was found in the United States, having knowingly and unlawfully reentered the United States without first applying to the Attorney General of the United States or his successor, the Secretary for Homeland Security (Title 6, United States Code, Sections 202(3),

(4) and 557), for permission to reapply for admission, and without receiving in response the express consent of the Attorney General or his successor to reapply for admission.

In violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(a).
