INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

At all times material to this indictment:

1. The Dunkin Donuts store, located at 3705 Germantown Avenue, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, was a business engaged in and affecting interstate commerce, including by providing to customers coffee products, beverages, and food products produced, purchased, and transported from New Jersey to Pennsylvania.

2. On or about June 17, 2013, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

obstructed, delayed and affected commerce and the movement of articles and commodities in

commerce, and attempted to do so, by robbery, in that, defendant GOODWIN unlawfully took and obtained United States currency, that is approximately \$215 belonging to the Dunkin Donuts store located at 3705 Germantown Avenue, in Philadelphia, from the person and in the presence of an employee of the Dunkin Donuts store and against his will, by means of actual and threatened force, violence, and fear of injury, immediate and future to his person and property, that is, by pointing a dangerous weapon and demanding money.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951(a).

COUNT TWO

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about June 19, 2013, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,
defendant

CARL ANTHONY GOODWIN,

having been committed to the custody of the Attorney General of the United States following his conviction of a felony, that is attempted bank robbery, in the United States District Court of the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, knowingly and without authorization escaped and remained absent from the Kintock Residential Reentry Center, 301 East Erie Avenue, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, that is, the federal institution or facility to which the defendant was lawfully confined at the direction of the Attorney General.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 751(a).

COUNT THREE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about June 20, 2013, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,
defendant

CARL ANTHONY GOODWIN

knowingly and unlawfully, by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of the Citizens Bank, located at 6324 Stenton Avenue in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, lawful currency of the United States, that is approximately \$709, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of the Citizens Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT FOUR

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about June 21, 2013, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,
defendant

CARL ANTHONY GOODWIN

knowingly and unlawfully, by force and violence, and by intimidation, attempted to take from employees of the Bank of America, located at 3745 Aramingo Avenue in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, lawful currency of the United States, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of the Bank of America, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT FIVE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about June 24, 2013, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,
defendant

CARL ANTHONY GOODWIN

knowingly and unlawfully, by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of the Beneficial Bank, located at 5301 Chew Avenue in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, lawful currency of the United States, that is approximately \$1,450, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of the Beneficial Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT SIX

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about July 2, 2013, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,
defendant

CARL ANTHONY GOODWIN

knowingly and unlawfully, by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of the Citizens Bank, located at 6324 Stenton Avenue in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, lawful currency of the United States, that is approximately \$1,312, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of the Citizens Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT SEVEN

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about July 8, 2013, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,
defendant

CARL ANTHONY GOODWIN

knowingly and unlawfully, by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of the Wells Fargo Bank, located at 861 Allegheny Avenue, in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, lawful currency of the United States, that is approximately \$1,600, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of the Wells Fargo Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).
