THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY CHARGES THAT:


On or about March 20, 2013, in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

PHILIPPE JEANNARD

knowingly and without lawful authority used a means of identification of another person, that is, a fraudulent Air France identification card of a former Air France employee, in connection with a felony under Pennsylvania law, that is, criminal trespass in violation of Title 18, Pennsylvania

Consolidated States, Section 3503, by using that fraudulent Air France identification card for access to the cockpit of US Airways Flight 1935.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 1028(a)(7), (b)(2)(B),
(c)(3)(A).
