INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about October 1, 2012, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

TANIKA VICTORIA LITTLE

knowingly possessed a firearm, that is, a Glock, model 19, 9mm pistol, serial #TN460US, which had the manufacturer's serial numbers removed, obliterated, and altered, that is, with a forcibly removed serial number plate from the frame and scratched serial number on the slide of the firearm, which firearm had been shipped and transported in interstate commerce, from Georgia to Pennsylvania.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(k) and 924(a)(1)(B).

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

As a result of the violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(k), set forth in this indictment, defendant

TANIA VICTORIA LITTLE

shall forfeit to the United States of America the firearm involved in the commission of this offenses, including, but not limited to:

1. A Glock, model 19, 9mm pistol, serial #TN460US

All pursuant to Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d).
