INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

At all times material to this indictment:

1. Defendant Lamont Lucas was a Tool Room Supervisor, that is, a prison guard, working at the Federal Detention Center in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

2. From in or about February 2012 to on or about May 16, 2012, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, in a Federal prison, defendant

LAMONT LUCAS

knowingly engaged in sexual acts, to wit, contact between the penis and vulva and contact between the mouth and penis, with L.B.N., a person who was, at that time, in official detention at the Federal Detention Center - Philadelphia, and under the custodial, supervisory, or disciplinary authority of the defendant, in that he was her supervisor in the prison tool room.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2243(b).

COUNT TWO

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about May 16, 2012, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

LAMONT LUCAS,

contrary to rule 28 CFR § 500.1(h), provided a prohibited object, that is, sterling silver studded earrings, objects that threatened the order, discipline, or security of the prison, to L.B.N., an inmate of the Federal Detention Center - Philadelphia.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1791(a)(1) and (b)(5).

COUNT THREE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

From on or about May 14, 2012 to on or about May 16, 2012, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

LAMONT LUCAS

knowingly instigated, aided and assisted in the attempted escape of L.B.N., a person committed to confinement, pursuant to a conviction for a felony, to wit, violations of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 371, 1344, 1028A, and 1030.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 752(a).
