

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about June 8, 2006, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,
defendant

ANGEL NATHAN MELENDEZ

knowingly and willfully made false statements in an application for an United States passport;
with intent to induce and secure for his own use, the issuance of a passport under the authority of
the United States, contrary to the laws regulating the issuance of passports and the rules
prescribed pursuant to such laws, that is, defendant MELENDEZ stated that his name was “D. D.
T.-G.,” that his date of birth was xx/xx/1978, and that his Social Security Number was xxx-xx-
2731, which statements he knew to be false.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1542.
