INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about August 31, 2013, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of
Pennsylvania, defendant

CURTIS RICHARDSON

knowingly and unlawfully, by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of
Conestoga Bank, 1032 Arch Street, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, lawful currency of the United
States, that is, approximately \$975, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management,
and possession of Conestoga Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit
Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT TWO

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about September 1, 2013, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

CURTIS RICHARDSON

knowingly and unlawfully, by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of Citizens Bank, 2001 Market Street, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$2,500, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of Citizens Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT THREE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about September 4, 2013, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

CURTIS RICHARDSON

knowingly and unlawfully, by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of Conestoga Bank, 1835 Market Street, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$1,209, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of Conestoga Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.
