INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about December 5, 2015, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant,

RAYMOND RYSHEEM E. STARR,

knowingly and intentionally possessed a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of oxycodone, a Schedule II controlled substance.

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 844.

COUNT TWO

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about December 5, 2014, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant,

RAYMOND RYSHEEM E. STARR,

having been convicted in a court of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, knowingly possessed in and affecting interstate commerce a firearm, that is, an FN Herstal Belgium, 5.7 x 28 caliber pistol, serial number 386123146, loaded with 20 rounds of 5.7 x 28 mm ammunition.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(1).

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

As a result of the violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(1), set forth in this indictment, defendant

RAYMOND RYSHEEM E. STARR

shall forfeit to the United States of America the firearm and ammunition involved in the commission of such offenses, including, but not limited to:

- a. FN Herstal Belgium, 5.7 x 28 caliber pistol, serial number 386123146, loaded with 20 rounds of 5.7 x 28 mm ammunition;
- b. FN Herstal magazine loaded with 19 rounds of 5.7 x 28 mm ammunition;
- c. FN Herstal magazine loaded with 5 rounds of 5.7 x 28 mm ammunition; and
- d. Smith & Wesson M&P-9 magazine.

All pursuant to Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d).
