Outpatient Pain Protocol

Day Before Surgery

- Acetaminophen (Tylenol) 625 mg QID 24hrs. prior to surgery
- Bextra 20mg P.O. x 1

Ambulatory Surgery Center prior to surgery

- Acetaminophen (Tylenol) 625 mg P.O.
- Percocet 7.5/325 or 10/325 (depending on age) P.O.
- Bextra 20mg P.O.

During Surgery

- Prior to incision inject 0.5% Marcaine
- If a regional nerve block is to be utilized for post-op analgesia do not administer any more Marcaine.

PACU

- Pain management per anesthesia protocol
- Cryocuff/ice per surgeon

Post Discharge

- Acetaminophen (Tylenol) 625mg QID x 4 days
- Bextra 20mg P.O. QD x 5 days
- Percocet 7.5/325 or 10/325 (depending on age) P.O. q6h x 5 days
- Cryocuff/ice Q3h x 5 days

Patient Discharge Note: Provide 2 Prescriptions 6 Pills/ Prescription. Patient paying cash out of pocket will incur a charge of \$18.00/ prescription. Co-pay for 1 prescription is \$35.

Caution: Avoid the use of Bextra and Celebrex in patients allergic to sulfonamides
