ORDER

This matter is before the Court on the Application of Michael J. Sullivan, United States Attorney for the District of Massachusetts, for an Order requiring Alex Alvarez to give testimony or provide other information pursuant to the provisions of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 6002 and 6003.


Upon consideration of the Application of the United States Attorney and it appearing to the satisfaction of this Court that:

1. Alex Alvarez has been called to testify or provide other information before a Jury of the United States within this District;
2. It is likely that Alex Alvarez will refuse to testify or provide other information before a Jury on the basis of Alex Alvarez's privilege against self-incrimination;
3. In the judgment of the United States Attorney, the testimony or other information from Alex Alvarez may be necessary to the public interest; and
4. The Application filed herein has been made with the approval of Kenneth A. Blanco,

Deputy Assistant Attorney General of the Criminal Division of the Department of Justice, pursuant to the authority vested by Title 18, United States Code, Section 6003(b) and Title 28, C.F.R., Section 0.175(a).

NOW, THEREFORE, if Alex Alvarez shall refuse, on the basis of Alex Alvarez's privilege against self-incrimination, to testify or provide other information in a proceeding before a Jury of the United States within this District, IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Sections 6002 and 6003, that Alex Alvarez shall give testimony or provide other information as to all matters about which Alex Alvarez may be interrogated before a Jury of the United States.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that no testimony or other information compelled under this Order (or any information directly or indirectly derived from such testimony or other information) may be used against Alex Alvarez in any criminal case except a prosecution for perjury, giving a false statement or otherwise failing to comply with this Order.
