U.S. v. Karlis et al

On January 30, 2012 the Court heard oral arguments of counsel on the revocation of defendants release. The court found under the statute by clear and convincing evidence that the defendant violated the conditions of release and based on the evidence before the court the defendant is unlikely to abide by any condition or combination of conditions of release and orders the defendant revoked and detained. The defendant has been remanded to the custody of the US Marshal.

The next scheduled court date for defendant Craig Karlis is a Status Conference for June 24, 2013 at 02:00 PM in Courtroom 24 before Ch. Magistrate Judge Leo T. Sorokin. Defendants typically do not attend status hearings.

Due to the large number of victims in this case, letters regarding status and motion hearings will not be mailed to the victims. We will however notify victims by mail of any trial, plea and sentencing hearing, as well as any hearings concerning bail.
