The United States Attorney's Office is currently prosecuting cases which allege, among other things, theft of personal identifying information of clients of the State of Alabama Department of Human Resources, former patients of Jackson Hospital, employees of Vinson Guard Service, Inc., and students who attended Jefferson Davis High School during the 2009-2010 school year and the use of that personal identifying information to prepare fraudulent tax returns. These alleged thefts of that information occurred between January 1, 2009 and March 25, 2011. An indictment is merely an accusation. A defendant is presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.

The Court further orders the Government to publish the following notice in the legal notices section of the Champion, which is published in DeKalb County, Georgia:

The theft of that information allegedly occurred between January 1, 2009 and March 25, 2011. An indictment is merely an accusation. A defendant is presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
