RESPONSE TO DEFENDANT’S MOTION FOR RELEASE FROM CUSTODY

Comes now the United States of America, by and through George L. Beck, Jr., United States Attorney for the Middle District of Alabama, and responds to the Defendant’s Motion for Release from Custody (“Motion”). (Doc. 54).

The Government and the Defendant’s counsel have reached an agreement in which the terms of the Defendant’s pre-trial release will be modified and, with the modification of those terms, the Government will not oppose the Defendant’s pre-trial release. The Government agrees with the Defendant that, upon his release, the Defendant should be required to submit to weekly testing for the use of controlled substances and should also be required to attend the Chemical Addictions Program (CAP). The Government has also consulted with the United States Probation officer who has been assigned to supervise the Defendant and that officer is not opposed to these conditions of the Defendant’s release. Because the Defendant agrees to the proposed modifications of pre-trial release, the Government does not oppose the Defendant’s Motion.
