THE UNITED STATES GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

COUNT 1

(Illegal Re-entry After Deportation)

On or about May 15, 2012, in the State and District of Minnesota, the defendant,

DANIEL GONZALEZ-DELEONE,
a/k/a Cesar Lopez,

an alien who had previously been removed from the United States on or about March 8, 2006, subsequent to a conviction for an aggravated felony, namely, a conviction on or about April 7, 2005, in Los Angeles County, California, for sale or transportation of marijuana, knowingly and unlawfully entered and was found in the United States without having obtained the consent of the Attorney General of the United States, or his successor, the Secretary of Homeland Security, to re-apply for admission into the United States in violation of Title 8, United States Code, Sections 1326(a) and 1326(b)(2), and Title 6, United States Code, Sections 202 and 557.
