COUNT 1

(Armed Career Criminal in Possession of a Firearm)

On or about May 5, 2012, in the State and District of Minnesota, the defendant,

WENDELL TERRELL BROWN,

having previously been convicted of one or more crimes punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, namely:

As a result of the foregoing offense, the defendant,

WENDELL TERRELL BROWN,

shall forfeit to the United States pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d)(1), any firearm with accessories or any ammunition involved in or used in any knowing violation of section 922(g)(1), including a Ruger, Model P94DAO 40 caliber pistol, serial number 340-49943.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(1) and 924(d)(1), and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c).
