THE UNITED STATES GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

COUNT 1

(Assault Resulting in Serious Bodily Injury)

On or about October 5, 2011, in the State and District of Minnesota and within the exterior boundaries of the Red Lake Indian Reservation, the defendant,

THOMAS PHILLIP SAYERS,

an enrolled member of the Red Lake Band of Chippewa Indians, did assault another enrolled member of the Red Lake Band of Chippewa, namely, C.R.E., resulting in serious bodily injury, to wit: fracturing his leg and causing abrasions to his face, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 113(a)(6), 1151, and 1153(a).
