23 COUNT ONE: (26 U.S.C. § 5861(d) – Possession of an Unregistered Firearm)

- 24 1. On or about May 31, 2014, in the Northern District of California, the defendant,

INDICTMENT

1 knowingly possessed a firearm, to wit: a destructive device as defined by Title 26, United States Code
2 §§ 5845(a)(8) and 5845(f), which was not registered to him in the National Firearms Registration and
3 Transfer Record; all in violation of Title 26, United States Code, Section 5861(d).

4 COUNT TWO: (18 U.S.C. § 922(k) – Possession of a Firearm with the Manufacturer’s Serial
5 Number Removed)

6 2. On or about May 31, 2014, in the Northern District of California, the defendant,
7 RYAN KELLY CHAMBERLAIN II,

8 knowingly possessed a firearm which had the manufacturer’s serial number removed, obliterated, or
9 altered, and had been shipped and transported in interstate and foreign commerce; all in violation of
10 Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(k).

11 FORFEITURE ALLEGATION: (26 U.S.C. § 5872; 18 U.S.C. § 924(d) - Forfeiture of Firearms and
12 Ammunition)

13 3. The factual allegations contained in Counts One and Two of this Indictment are re-
14 alleged and by this reference fully incorporated herein for the purpose of alleging forfeiture.

15 4. Upon a conviction of the offense alleged in Count One of this Indictment, the defendant,
16 RYAN KELLY CHAMBERLAIN II,
17 shall, pursuant to Title 26, United States Code, Section 5872, forfeit to the United States any firearm as
18 defined in 26, United States Code, Section 5845(a), involved in said violation, including but not limited
19 to the following:

20 a. Components of an improvised explosive device seized on or about May 31, 2013.

21 5. Upon a conviction of the offense alleged in Count Two of this Indictment, the defendant,
22 RYAN KELLY CHAMBERLAIN II,
23 shall, pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d), forfeit to the United States any firearm
24 or ammunition involved in or used in any knowing violation of said offense, including, but not limited
