**NOTICE: VICTIMS' RIGHTS TO BE HEARD AND TO OBTAIN RESTITUTION
WITH REGARD TO SECURITIES FRAUD INVOLVING CARTER'S, INC. (NYSE: CRI)**

Two former executives of Carter's, Inc. (NYSE: CRI) have been indicted by a federal grand jury in Atlanta, Georgia, for violating certain federal securities laws in connection with the securities of Carter's, Inc. between 2006 and 2009, and thereby defrauding Carter's, Inc. shareholders. The charges are pending in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Georgia, Atlanta Division, Case No. 1:11-CR-445-JEC-AJB. **PLEASE NOTE THAT AN INDICTMENT IS AN ACCUSATION. ALL DEFENDANTS ARE PRESUMED INNOCENT UNLESS AND UNTIL PROVEN GUILTY.** Pursuant to the "Justice for All Act of 2004" (18 U.S.C. § 3771), federal law entitles any victim of a federal criminal defendant's alleged fraudulent acts to receive advance notice of public proceedings and possibly to restitution. Victims also have a reasonable right to be heard in such proceedings, including during a sentencing hearing. A toll-free telephone hotline has been established in order to provide information about the case to anyone directly affected by the alleged fraud.

If you believe that you or your organization may be a victim in this case, please call **1-888-431-1918**.

The purpose of the hotline is to provide any individuals who may have been affected by the alleged fraud between the years of 2006 and 2009 a means to contact the government to obtain information about their potential rights in federal court, notice of any scheduled proceedings, and to speak with a government contact if they wish.
