COUNT ONE

The SPECIAL AUGUST 2012 GRAND JURY charges:

On or about September 6, 2010, at Midlothian, in the Northern District of Illinois, Eastern Division,

STEVEN G. ZAMIAR,

defendant herein, acting under color of law as Detective Sergeant of the Midlothian Police Department, willfully subjected Victim A to the deprivation of rights secured and protected by the Constitution and laws of the United States, specifically, the right to be free from unreasonable seizure, which includes the right to be free from the use of unreasonable force by a law enforcement officer, with bodily injury resulting from the acts committed by defendant;

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 242.

COUNT TWO

The SPECIAL AUGUST 2012 GRAND JURY further charges:

On or about November 24, 2011, at Midlothian, in the Northern District of Illinois, Eastern Division,

STEVEN G. ZAMIAR,

defendant herein, acting under color of law as Deputy Chief of the Midlothian Police Department, willfully subjected Victim B to the deprivation of rights secured and protected by the Constitution and laws of the United States, specifically, the right to be free from unreasonable seizure, which includes the right to be free from the use of unreasonable force by a law enforcement officer, with bodily injury resulting from the acts committed by defendant, and which acts committed by defendant included the use, attempted use, and threatened use of a dangerous weapon;

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 242.
