I N F O R M A T I O N

The defendant having waived in open Court prosecution by Indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

COUNT ONE
(Bank Robbery)

1. On or about September 26, 2011, in Somerset County, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, the defendant

ANDREA DORSEY

did knowingly, by force, violence, and intimidation, take, and attempt to take, from the person and presence of another, approximately \$20,339.00 in United States currency belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of the Financial Resources Federal Credit Union, located in Somerset, New Jersey, whose deposits were then insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, and in committing such offense, did assault and put in jeopardy the life of another person by the use of a dangerous weapon, that is a firearm.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections
2113(a), 2113(d), and 2.

COUNT TWO
(Bank Robbery)

2. On or about November 21, 2011, in Somerset County, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, the defendant

ANDREA DORSEY

did knowingly, by force, violence, and intimidation, take, and attempt to take, from the person and presence of another, approximately \$14,691.00 in United States currency belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of the Somerset Savings Bank, located in Somerville, New Jersey, whose deposits were then insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, and in committing such offense, did assault and put in jeopardy the life of another person by the use of a dangerous weapon, that is a firearm.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2113(a), 2113(d), and 2.

COUNT THREE
(Bank Robbery)

3. On or about June 20, 2012, in Middlesex County, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, the defendant

ANDREA DORSEY

did knowingly, by force, violence, and intimidation, take, and attempt to take, from the person and presence of another, approximately \$6,928.00 in United States currency belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of the Fulton Bank, located in Metuchen, New Jersey, whose deposits were then insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, and in committing such offense, did assault and put in jeopardy the life of another person by the use of a dangerous weapon, that is a firearm.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2113(a), 2113(d), and 2.
