LANCE HADLEY : I N F O R M A T I O N

The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by Indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

1. At all times relevant to this Information:

(A) Defendant LANCE HADLEY was the sole owner and principal of Lancescaping, a landscaping company, based in Brick Township, New Jersey.

(B) The Town Employee was the Director of the Brick Township Department of Public Works ("BTDPW"). The Town Employee was responsible for, among other things, hiring and deploying companies to plow snow in the Town of Brick during emergency snow conditions, i.e., when it snowed more than five or six inches.

(C) Brick Township is a local government entity that received benefits in excess of \$10,000 in Federal assistance during the relevant one-year period.

2. Between in or about December 2002 and in or about March 2003, the Town Employee hired Lancescaping to plow snow in Brick Township on an emergency basis on at least three occasions, all valued in excess of \$5,000.

3. On or about March 19, 2003, defendant LANCE HADLEY made a concealed, corrupt payment of \$2,000 to the Town Employee in exchange for the Town Employee exercising his official influence in the awarding of the emergency snow plowing contracts to Lancescaping.

4. On or about March 19, 2003, in Ocean County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, defendant

LANCE HADLEY

did knowingly, willfully, and corruptly give, offer, and agree to give a thing of value, namely a cash payment to the Town Employee, with intent to influence and reward the Town Employee in connection with a business, transaction, and series of transactions of Brick Township involving a thing of value of \$5,000 and more.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 666(a)(2) and 2.
