
The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by Indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

On or about July 27, 2011, in Bergen County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, the defendant,

BERNARD FOWLER,

in a matter within the jurisdiction of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Office of the Inspector General ("HHS-OIG"), a part of the Executive Branch of the United States, did knowingly and willfully make a materially false, fictitious, and fraudulent statement and representation, namely, a representation to special agents with HHS-OIG that he had never used a single vial of the prescription medication Lucentis on multiple patients, when in fact he knew that he did administer medication from a single vial of Lucentis to more than one patient and that he did so on multiple occasions during 2008 and 2009.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1001.
