
The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

Between in or about August 2012 through in or about October 2012, in Cape May County, New Jersey, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, the defendant,

MICHAEL KULICK,

did knowingly transport and attempt to transport an individual, that is, a minor girl, in interstate commerce, with the intent that such individual engage in any sexual activity for which any person can be charged with a criminal offense, namely N.J.S.A. § 2C:14-2c(4) and 18 Pa.C.S.A. § 3122.1(b).

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2421.
