In or about March 2013, in Passaic County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, defendant

did knowingly possess, and access with intent to view, material which contains at least three images of child pornography, as defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 2256(8)(A), which images were mailed, shipped and transported using any means and facility of interstate and foreign commerce and were produced using materials that have been moved, shipped and transported in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce by any means, including by computer, after having been convicted in Passaic County Superior Court of Endangering the Welfare of a Child, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:24-4(a).

2252A(a)(5)(B) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.
