COUNT ONE  
(Dealing in Firearms Without A License)

From in or about May 2012 to on or about August 15, 2012, in Camden County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, the defendant,

AMMIE STEWARD,  
a/k/a "Beav,"  
a/k/a "B,"

did knowingly and willfully engage in the business of dealing in firearms without a license by selling and transferring the following firearms:

1. Kel Tec P11 9 millimeter handgun bearing serial number AGS46 (sold on or about July 8, 2012);
2. Kel Tec PF-9 9 millimeter handgun bearing serial number S9M59 (sold on or about July 8, 2012);
3. Kel Tec PLR-16 .223 caliber pistol bearing an obliterated serial number (sold on or about July 23, 2012);

4. Smith and Wesson model SW9VE, 9 millimeter handgun, bearing an obliterated serial number (sold on or about July 25, 2012);
5. Ruger SR9C 9 millimeter handgun, bearing an obliterated serial number (sold on or about July 27, 2012);
6. Rossi M677 .357 caliber revolver bearing an obliterated serial number (sold on or about July 27, 2012);
7. Intratec AB-10 9 millimeter pistol, bearing an obliterated serial number (sold on or about July 30, 2012);
8. Glock Model 36, .45 caliber handgun bearing an obliterated serial number (sold on or about July 30, 2012);
9. Intratec AB-10 9 millimeter pistol, bearing an obliterated serial number (sold on or about July 31, 2012);
10. Ruger Model LC9 9 millimeter pistol, bearing an obliterated serial number (sold on or about July 31, 2012);
11. Glock Model 27, .40 caliber handgun bearing an obliterated serial number (sold on or about August 1, 2012);
12. Ruger Model SR40C .40 caliber handgun, bearing an obliterated serial number (sold on or about August 1, 2012);
13. Intratec TEC-DC9 9 millimeter pistol, bearing an obliterated serial number (sold on or about August 13, 2012);
14. Intratec TEC-DC9 9 millimeter pistol, bearing an obliterated serial number (sold on or about August 13, 2012);
15. Romarm/Cugir, WASR 10/63 .762 caliber rifle, bearing an obliterated serial number (sold on or about August 15, 2012); and
16. Hi Point Model 4095, .40 caliber rifle, bearing an obliterated serial number (sold on or about August 15, 2012);

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section  
922(a)(1)(A) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.


COUNT TWO  
(Felon-in-possession Of A Firearm)

having been convicted of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year in a court in the State of New Jersey, did knowingly possess in and affecting commerce a firearm, namely, a Romarm/Cugir, WASR 10/63 .762 caliber rifle, bearing an obliterated serial number.
