I N F O R M A T I O N

The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by Indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

COUNT ONE
(Hobbs Act Robbery)

1. At all times material to this Information, Target was a commercial establishment with a store located at 2235 Springfield Avenue, Union, New Jersey (the "Target") and was engaged in selling merchandise that moved in, was transferred in, and affected interstate and foreign commerce.

2. On or about November 23, 2012, in Union County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, the defendant,

DARRELL A. CARTER, did knowingly and willfully obstruct, delay, and affect, and attempt to obstruct, delay, and affect, commerce, as that term is defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951, and the movement of articles and commodities in such commerce, by robbery, as that term is defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951, in that the defendant and others did

unlawfully take and obtain property consisting of United States currency from the Target in the presence of its employees, and committed and threatened physical violence to persons and property in furtherance thereof.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951(a) and Section 2.


COUNT TWO
(Brandishing a Firearm During a Crime of Violence)

On or about November 23, 2012, in Union County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, the defendant,

DARRELL A. CARTER,

during and in relation to a crime of violence for which he may be prosecuted in a court of the United States, namely, the violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 1951(a) and 2, as charged in Count One of this Information, did knowingly use and carry a firearm, which was brandished, and did aid and abet the same.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(c) (1) (A) (ii) and Section 2.
