INFORMATION

The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by Indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

COUNT ONE

On or about July 3, 2013, in Hudson County, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, defendant

MARIO RODRIGUEZ,
a/k/a "Mad Dog"

did unlawfully transport, transmit, and transfer in interstate commerce from Secaucus, New Jersey, to Staten Island, New York, stolen goods, wares and merchandise, that is, cigarettes and televisions, of the value of \$5,000 or more, knowing the same to have been stolen, converted, and taken by fraud.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2314 and 2.

COUNT TWO

On or about July 24, 2013, in Hudson County, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, defendant

MARIO RODRIGUEZ,
a/k/a "Mad Dog"

did knowingly and intentionally conspire and agree with others to obstruct, delay, and affect commerce and the movement of articles and commodities in commerce by extortion, that is, defendant obtained property not due defendant or his office, from another individual, with the individual's consent, under color of official right.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 1951(a) and 2.
