did knowingly possess material that contained at least three images of child pornography, as defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 2256(8)(A), which images were mailed, shipped, and transported using any means and facility of interstate and foreign commerce and in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce by any means, including by computer, and which were produced using materials that were mailed, shipped, and transported in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce, by any means, including by computer.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2252A(a)(5)(B).
