The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

COUNT 1

1. On or about February 12, 2011, in Monmouth County, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, the defendant,

TIMOTHY LESTER JOHNSON,  
a/k/a "Amiri Allah,"

did knowingly, by force and violence, and by intimidation, take from the persons and presence of the employees of the PNC Bank, 4620 Route 9 South, Howell, New Jersey, money belonging to and in the care, custody, control, management and possession of the bank, a financial institution whose deposits were then insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

COUNT 2

1. At all times relevant to this Information, "Dunkin Donuts Perth Amboy" was a commercial establishment located at 587 Fayette Street, Perth Amboy, New Jersey, engaged in selling food, coffee, and other items that moved and were transferred in interstate and foreign commerce.

2. At all times relevant to this Information, an individual with the initials E.C. was employed at Dunkin Donuts Perth Amboy. On or about February 6, 2011, E.C. was responsible for maintaining and safeguarding proceeds of the commercial sales of food, coffee, and other items on behalf of Dunkin Donuts Perth Amboy.

3. On or about February 6, 2011, in Middlesex County, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, the defendant,

TIMOTHY LESTER JOHNSON,  
a/k/a "Amiri Allah,"

did knowingly and willfully obstruct, delay and affect commerce and the movement of articles and commodities in commerce by robbing E.C. of business proceeds belonging to Dunkin Donuts Perth Amboy, and did commit and threaten physical violence to persons and property in furtherance thereof.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951(a), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

COUNT 3

1. At all times relevant to this Information, "Dunkin Donuts Ocean Township" was a commercial establishment located at 2112 Highway 35 South, Ocean Township, New Jersey, engaged in selling food, coffee, and other items that moved and were transferred in interstate and foreign commerce.


2. At all times relevant to this Information, an individual with the initials A.M. was employed at Dunkin Donuts Ocean Township. On or about February 11, 2011, A.M. was responsible for maintaining and safeguarding proceeds of the commercial sales of food and other items on behalf of Dunkin Donuts Ocean Township.

3. On or about February 11, 2011, in Monmouth County, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, the defendant,

TIMOTHY LESTER JOHNSON,  
a/k/a "Amiri Allah,"

did knowingly and willfully obstruct, delay and affect commerce and the movement of articles and commodities in commerce by robbing A.M. of business proceeds belonging to Dunkin Donuts Ocean Township, and did commit and threaten physical violence to persons and property in furtherance thereof.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951(a), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.
