knowingly and intentionally conspire and agree with each other and others to distribute and possess with intent to distribute 280 grams or more of a mixture and substance containing cocaine base, that is, crack cocaine, a Schedule II controlled substance, contrary to Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(A)

in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846.

I further state that I am a Special Agent with Immigration and Customs Enforcement, Department of Homeland Security Investigations and that this Complaint is based on the following facts:

ATTACHMENT A

I, Ricky A. Miller, am a Special Agent with Immigration and Customs Enforcement, Department of Homeland Security Investigations. I am fully familiar with the facts set forth herein based on my own investigation, my conversations with other law enforcement officers, and my review of reports, documents, and items of evidence. Where statements of others are related herein, they are related in substance and part. Since this Complaint is being submitted for a limited purpose, I have not set forth each and every fact that I know concerning this investigation. Where I assert that an event took place on a particular date, I am asserting that it took place on or about the date alleged.

1. Beginning in or about February 2010, Special Agents with Immigration and Customs Enforcement, Department of Homeland Security Investigations ("DHS") have been investigating defendants MARK MANASSE, a/k/a "M-Easy"; BRADNEY MANASSE, a/k/a "Ice"; TAFARY CLERVIL, a/k/a "Birdie"; DONALD DUTERVAL; LIGUNES BONNET, a/k/a/ "LB"; LEVELSTON GEORGES; PHILEMON PIERRE-SAINT, a/k/a "Butter"; CHENETE PHILEMON, a/k/a "Jumanji"; THIMOTE "TIM" PIERCIN; DAVID GLASS, a/k/a "GRIM"; ANQUAN CLARK, a/k/a "GS"; AKMAD ANDERSON, a/k/a "POP"; WALLY MANASSE; JOVANY CLERMONT, a/k/a "Rims"; ISRAEL PETIOTE, a/k/a "Little Easy" and others (hereinafter collectively referred to as "the Defendants") who are members of a criminal street gang involved in distributing drugs in and around Essex County, New Jersey.

2. During the course of the investigation, Special Agents utilized a Confidential Source (hereinafter "CS") who has provided reliable information in the past to law enforcement. Through the use of CS, law enforcement conducted a series of controlled purchases of controlled substances from the Defendants as well as conducted surveillance of the Defendants and their drug trafficking activity in and around Essex County.

3. On or about December 19, 2010, CS contacted MARK MANASSE (hereinafter "MANASSE") for the purpose of purchasing crack cocaine from MANASSE. MANASSE advised CS to contact BRADNEY MANASSE a/k/a "ICE" (hereinafter "B. MANASSE") who would provide CS the crack cocaine. CS then made arrangements with B. MANASSE to meet at a location in the city of Irvington to conduct the transaction. Law enforcement established surveillance in the area where CS was observed meeting with B. MANASSE and JOVANY CLERMONT, a/k/a "Rims" (hereinafter "CLERMONT"). CS was provided a quantity of crack cocaine by B. MANASSE on consignment.

Immediately following the transaction, CS met with law enforcement at a pre-determined location and provided Special Agents a clear plastic bag containing approximately 5 grams of crack cocaine, which was placed into evidence.

4. On or about December 20, 2010, CS contacted MANASSE for the purpose of purchasing crack cocaine from MANASSE. MANASSE advised CS to contact B. MANASSE, who would provide CS crack cocaine. Several days later on or about December 23, 2010, CS contacted B. MANASSE for the purpose of purchasing crack cocaine and paying B. MANASSE \$500 for the crack cocaine B. MANASSE provided CS on December 19, 2010. B. MANASSE advised CS to meet him at a location in the city of Irvington to conduct the transaction. Law enforcement established surveillance in the area and observed B. MANASSE arrive at the location and provide CS with a package wrapped in clear plastic containing crack cocaine again on consignment. CS paid \$500 for the crack cocaine that B. MANASSE gave CS on consignment on December 19, 2010. Immediately following the transaction, CS met with law enforcement at a pre-determined location and provided Special Agents a clear plastic bag containing approximately 6 grams of crack cocaine, which was placed into evidence. Several days later on or about December 30, 2010 CS met with B. MANASSE for the purpose of paying him \$500 for the crack cocaine B. MANASSE provided CS on December 23, 2010.

5. On or about January 12, 2011, CS contacted MANASSE for the purpose of purchasing crack cocaine from MANASSE. MANASSE advised CS that he would provide CS crack cocaine and that B. MANASSE would be the individual to meet CS to conduct the transaction. CS then arranged to meet B. MANASSE in the city of Irvington. Law enforcement established surveillance in the area and observed CS and B. MANASSE meet where B. MANASSE provided CS a bag containing crack cocaine in exchange for \$900. Immediately following the transaction, CS met with law enforcement at a pre-determined location and provided Special Agents a clear plastic bag containing approximately 21 grams of crack cocaine, which was placed into evidence.

6. On or about February 8, 2011, CS contacted MANASSE for the purpose of purchasing crack cocaine from MANASSE. MANASSE advised CS to meet him at a location in the city of Irvington to conduct the transaction. Law enforcement established surveillance in the area and observed CS meet MANASSE where MANASSE provided CS a bag containing crack cocaine in exchange for \$1,000. Immediately following the transaction, CS met with law enforcement at a pre-determined location and provided Special Agents a clear plastic bag containing approximately 27 grams of

crack cocaine, which was placed into evidence.

7. On or about February 28, 2011, CS contacted MANASSE for the purpose of purchasing crack cocaine from MANASSE. MANASSE and CS arranged to meet at a location in the city Irvington to conduct the transaction. Law enforcement established surveillance in the area and observed MANASSE and B. MANASSE arrive at the location where MANASSE provided CS a bag containing crack cocaine in exchange for \$1,800. Immediately following the transaction, CS met with law enforcement at a pre-determined location and provided Special Agents a clear plastic bag containing approximately 48 grams of crack cocaine, which was placed into evidence.

8. On or about March 11, 2011, CS contacted MANASSE for the purpose of purchasing crack cocaine from MANASSE. MANASSE and CS arranged to meet at a location in the city of Irvington to conduct the transaction. Law enforcement established surveillance in the area and observed CS and MANASSE meet at the location where MANASSE provided CS a bag containing crack cocaine in exchange for \$3,000. Immediately following the transaction, CS met with law enforcement at a pre-determined location and provided Special Agents a clear plastic bag containing approximately 70 grams of crack cocaine, which was placed into evidence.

9. On or about April 5, 2011, CS contacted MANASSE for the purpose of purchasing crack cocaine from MANASSE. MANASSE and CS arranged to meet at a location in the city of Irvington to conduct the transaction. Law enforcement established surveillance in the area and observed MANASSE and B. MANASSE arrive at the location where MANASSE then provided CS crack cocaine in exchange for \$3,000. Immediately following the transaction, CS met with law enforcement at a pre-determined location and provided Special Agents a clear plastic bag containing approximately 60 grams of crack cocaine, which was placed into evidence.

10. On or about April 12, 2011, CS contacted MANASSE for the purpose of purchasing crack cocaine from MANASSE. MANASSE and CS arranged to meet at a location in the city of Irvington to conduct the transaction. Law enforcement established surveillance in the area and observed MANASSE and B. MANASSE arrive at the location where MANASSE provide CS a bag containing crack cocaine in exchange for \$2,800. Immediately following the transaction, CS met with law enforcement at a pre-determined location and provided Special Agents a clear plastic bag containing approximately 82 grams of crack cocaine, which was

placed into evidence.

11. In addition to the aforementioned drug transactions, on or about December 13, 2010, while conducting surveillance, law enforcement observed Levelston Georges engage in several hand to hand drug transactions with individuals in the area of 18th Avenue and Columbia Avenue in Irvington, New Jersey. After making these observations, law enforcement approached Levelston Georges and seized approximately 8 bags of crack cocaine from his person.

12. On or about January 20, 2011, while conducting surveillance in the area of 18th Avenue and Columbia Avenue, law enforcement observed several individuals including Donald Duterval and Levelston Georges engaging in several hand to hand drug transactions with other individuals in the area. After making these observations, law enforcement approached Donald Duterval, Levelston Georges and the other individuals where drugs were seized, including 15 bags of crack cocaine that was in the possession of Donald Duterval.

13. Law enforcement was able to identify two cellular telephones utilized by MANASSE to conduct his drug trafficking activity. Special Agents thereafter obtained Court Orders authorizing interception of wire communications occurring over the two cellular telephones used by MANASSE (hereinafter the "FIRST MANASSE FACILITY" and the "SECOND MANASSE FACILITY").

14. The following paragraphs contain descriptions of conversations intercepted over the FIRST MANASSE FACILITY and the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY, which were translated from Haitian Creole to English. In this Complaint, various events, including telephone conversations, are indicated as having begun at specific times. These times are based upon information obtained from clocks used by recording equipment, service providers, and law enforcement officers. These clocks often vary slightly among themselves. Accordingly, all times indicated in this Complaint are approximate. The descriptions of intercepted calls discussed below are based on summaries of the conversations prepared by law enforcement officers. The descriptions, comments are based upon my knowledge, training, and experience, as well as upon the results of the investigation to date. While care has been taken to give accurate descriptions of the conversations intercepted, they should not be taken as verbatim transcripts. Portions in quotes are not direct quotes from the recorded conversations, but rather quotes from the descriptions the monitoring personnel wrote in line sheets summarizing the conversations.

15. On February 21, 2011, at 3:52 p.m., in call number 11219, MANASSE received an incoming call over the FIRST MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with B. MANASSE. B. MANASSE stated, "you done that thing? MANASSE replied, "yeah almost done." B. MANASSE responded, "bring me some buzz." MANASSE replied, "alright." Here, B. MANASSE was asking MANASSE to bring him some "buzz" which is code for crack-cocaine.

16. On February 22, 2011, at 12:15 p.m., in call number 11321, MANASSE received an incoming call over the FIRST MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with B. MANASSE. B. MANASSE stated, "are you finished doing the thing?" MANASSE replied, "yeah, yeah, I am finished doing it, I put the thing in the little small bags." B. MANASSE responded, "huh! You didn't even let it dry man?" MANASSE replied, "no, no, the thing was dry son, when it's hard like that, that shit is dry son, they put the thing in bags." B. MANASSE responded, "who did you give some?" MANASSE replied, "'Grim', I just gave it to him, I gave him 3 and told him to give Herby some, I didn't have time to bag up the rest. I put everything in bags, like another 14 man...I bagged 10 only." Here, B. MANASSE asked whether MANASSE had prepared bags of crack-cocaine. MANASSE indicated that he had just finished preparing the bags and that he provided DAVID GLASS, a/k/a "Grim" 3 bags. MANASSE further indicated that he did not have time to bag up the remaining amount of crack-cocaine and only prepared approximately 10 bags.

17. On February 25, 2011, at 11:21 a.m., in call number 11734, MANASSE received an incoming call over the FIRST MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with B. MANASSE. MANASSE stated, "I know...you see the other, the thing...?" B. MANASSE responded, "yo, that thing is good too!" MANASSE replied, "what...they like it?" B. MANASSE responded, "the new arrival man." MANASSE replied, "they like it better than the other one?" B. MANASSE responded, "'Papo's thing." MANASSE replied, "oh, they like 'Papo's' thing." B. MANASSE responded, "yeah, they still say the same about our thing man...they say 'Papo's' thing is good, it burns." MANASSE replied, "you know what I suspect is that he does not cut it." Here, B. MANASSE is explaining to MANASSE that their customers like the quality of the most recent crack cocaine that was provided by an individual named "Papo." Papo is a supplier of drugs for MANASSE and others. The conversation continued with B. MANASSE explaining that the customers still liked the drugs MANASSE was providing but also thought "Papo's" crack cocaine was good quality.

18. On February 24, 2011, at 10:08 p.m., in call number 463, MANASSE made an outgoing call over the SECOND MANASSE

FACILITY and spoke with B. MANASSE. MANASSE stated, "what's his name is trying to meet up with you to give some samples." B. MANASSE replied, "you say what?" MANASSE responded, "Papo." B. MANASSE replied, "what's going on?" MANASSE responded, "he wants to meet with you." B. MANASSE replied, "he is trying to give some or try to get some?" MANASSE responded, "he is trying to meet up to give you something...a sample." B. MANASSE replied, "alright, tell him I am on Isabella." Here, MANASSE was explaining to B. MANASSE that an individual by the name of "Papo" had some samples of narcotics that he wanted to give to B. MANASSE to see how well they would move to customers in the street. B. MANASSE told MANASSE to tell "Papo" that he was on Isabella street in Irvington selling drugs if "Papo" wanted to meet him at that location.

19. On February 25, 2011, at 5:22 p.m., in call number 611, MANASSE made an outgoing call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with PHILEMON PIERRE-SAINT, a/k/a "Butter" (hereinafter "PIERRE-SAINT"). MANASSE stated, "hello." PIERRE-SAINT replied, "yo is good." MANASSE responded, "yo is good, who this?" PIERRE-SAINT replied, "Butter." MANASSE responded, "oh! Is good..." PIERRE-SAINT replied, "what's up with that other shit you were talking about bro?" MANASSE responded, "I got to come to with that shit alright." PIERRE-SAINT replied, "you got some now?" MANASSE responded, "yeah, yeah, yeah." PIERRE-SAINT replied, "alright, bring me some so I can see what it is." MANASSE responded, "I got you bro." PIERRE-SAINT replied, "can you bring it now?" MANASSE responded, "I got to get them and bring it now, I got you." PIERRE-SAINT replied, "how long? Because I'm in the bottom." MANASSE responded, "I'll be there in 15...15 minutes alright." PIERRE-SAINT replied, "alright..." Here, PIERRE-SAINT was asking whether MANASSE had the drugs that MANASSE had mentioned to PIERRE-SAINT during an earlier conversation. MANASSE confirmed that he had drugs and PIERRE-SAINT then asked for MANASSE to meet him because PIERRE-SAINT wanted to see the drugs and buy some from MANASSE because PIERRE-SAINT was running low and needed more to sell on the streets.

20. On February 26, 2011, at 6:49 p.m., in call number 1081, MANASSE received an incoming call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with TAFARY CLERVIL, a/k/a "Birdy" (hereinafter "CLERVIL"). CLERVIL stated, "you ain't get that shit..." MANASSE replied, "yeah, I'm about to get, which..." CLERVIL responded, "what you going to do bring it to me?" MANASSE replied, "come to me." CLERVIL responded, "where I have to come to?" MANASSE replied, "you want to put it together or you going to put it together?" CLERVIL responded, "I can put it together." MANASSE replied, "alright then...come on Park Ave."

CLERVIL responded, "alright, I'm going to call you when I'm outside." Here, CLERVIL was asking whether MANASSE had drugs available for CLERVIL to pick up. MANASSE indicated he had drugs and told CLERVIL to meet him at the residence located on Park Avenue. MANASSE was discussing whether CLERVIL was going to prepare the crack himself or whether he wanted MANASSE to prepare it for him. CLERVIL indicated that he would prepare the crack himself.

21. On February 28, 2011, at 12:43 p.m., in call number 1541, MANASSE received an incoming call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with ANQUAN CLARK, a/k/a "GS" (hereinafter "CLARK"). MANASSE stated, "yo, whats' up bro?" CLARK replied, "mother fucker 'Grim' told me he is about to come by me to give me some bread and shit...this wasn't supposed to be like that..." MANASSE responded, "you ain't make no bread?" CLARK replied, "no, this shit slow, I have been out there." MANASSE responded, "it's going to be rocking tonight." Here, CLARK is explaining to MANASSE that he is frustrated because DAVID GLASS, a/k/a "Grim" was supposed to give him some money and he did not. CLARK is also frustrated because he has not made any drug sales. MANASSE indicated that business should increase that evening for CLARK.

22. On March 2, 2011, at 8:50 a.m., in call number 2295, MANASSE made an outgoing call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with AKMAD ANDERSON, a/k/a "Pop" (hereinafter "ANDERSON"). ANDERSON stated, "hey Mark, what's up?" MANASSE replied, "good son." ANDERSON responded, "cool man." MANASSE replied, "I got some buzz and shit." ANDERSON responded, "hey look, let me give you the rest of the money for that, I guarantee that should move fast you heard." MANASSE replied, "alright, I got you bro." Here, MANASSE explained that he had "buzz" (a street term for crack cocaine) available. ANDERSON indicated that he would take the crack cocaine MANASSE had and would be able to sell it quickly.

23. On March 3, 2011, at 5:12 p.m., in call number 2617, MANASSE made an outgoing call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with JOVANY CLERMONT, a/k/a "Rims" (hereinafter "CLERMONT"). MANASSE stated, "the bit money came man, you received your cut? It's goody goody." CLERMONT replied, "I didn't get shit son...I ain't get shit buzzer." MANASSE responded, "it's good man." CLERMONT replied, "I'm gonna come back for that." Here, MANASSE was asking whether CLERMONT got a cut of the drugs that MANASSE and others received. CLERMONT indicated that he did not receive any crack cocaine (i.e. "buzzer") and was frustrated but that he would get it later.

24. On March 3, 2011, at 6:22 p.m., in call number 2675, MANASSE made an outgoing call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with JOVANY CLERMONT. MANASSE stated, "where are you man?" CLERMONT replied, "in front of my crib." MANASSE responded, "we are bringing the money man." CLERMONT replied, "the ... leaves at 6 son...so we got to wait until tomorrow." MANASSE responded, "shit man...I need to fucking bust a move man." CLERMONT replied, "that ... is gone son...tomorrow, I told him to put it together for tomorrow." Here, MANASSE was discussing with CLERMONT how he was bringing CLERMONT money for CLERMONT's source of drugs. CLERMONT explained that it was too late because the source of supply had left but that tomorrow there would be drugs available for MANASSE to purchase. MANASSE was frustrated because he needed to make some money from selling drugs.

25. On March 5, 2011, at 11:40 a.m., in call number 3047, MANASSE made an outgoing call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with JOVANY CLERMONT. MANASSE stated, "what's going on man?...you have not called me back...where are you man?" CLERMONT replied, "I'm in the crib, I just got out of the shower." MANASSE responded, "you're not selling anymore?" CLERMONT replied, "yeah, what you say son?" MANASSE responded, "seems like you don't go out anymore." CLERMONT replied, "on what?" MANASSE responded, "Buzz." CLERMONT replied, "yeah, as much as I need to make money." MANASSE responded, "I'm not talking...I'm talking about buzz." CLERMONT replied, "there are no runners man." MANASSE responded, "there is nobody outside those that don't have you just give them some." CLERMONT replied, "nah, I don't want to give a runner buzz...why would I do that son?" MANASSE responded, "because things are jumping man, I made a thousand dollars man." Here, MANASSE is asking why CLERMONT has not been out selling drugs recently. CLERMONT explained that he was only selling when he needed to make money and that he had no one to sell drugs for him at that time and did not want to let "runners" sell for him¹. MANASSE suggested that CLERMONT get someone outside to sell "buzz" (i.e. crack cocaine) because MANASSE already made \$1,000.

26. On March 5, 2011, at 6:11 p.m., in call number 3171, MANASSE made an outgoing call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY

¹ Based on my training and experience a "runner" is an individual who sells drugs for drug dealers and are often drug users themselves. CLERMONT did not want to let a "runner" sell crack for him because he was worried they may steal it for their own use.

and spoke with AKMAD ANDERSON. MANASSE stated, "hey 'Pop' come outside cause I'm about to bring you something...you heard?" ANDERSON replied, "yeah...I got like 160, 140...you want that shit?" MANASSE responded, "fuck it, I will grab it but come outside." Here, MANASSE is explaining that he has more drugs for ANDERSON to sell for MANASSE. ANDERSON indicated that he had approximately \$160 or \$140 for MANASSE from drugs he sold for MANASSE.

27. On March 4, 2011, at 8:25 p.m., in call number 12707, MANASSE received an incoming call over the FIRST MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with TAFARY CLERVIL. CLERVIL stated, "yo, the American guy is done." MANASSE replied, "alright, alright." CLERVIL responded, "you want me to get the money?" MANASSE replied, "yeah, take it, because I am gonna..." CLERVIL responded, "let me let you talk to him...hold on..." An unidentified male (hereinafter "UM") begins to talk to MANASSE. MANASSE stated, "what up bro?" UM replied, "what up..." MANASSE responded, "alright, give it to 'Birdy' and shit, I'm about to come through." Here, CLERVIL was explaining to MANASSE that UM was finished selling the drugs MANASSE provided and had money ready for MANASSE. MANASSE told CLERVIL to get the money from UM and MANASSE would be by later to pick it up.

28. On March 4, 2011, at 8:13 p.m., in call number 2992, MANASSE received an incoming call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with ANQUAN CLARK. MANASSE stated, "you good, you alright?" CLARK replied, "yeah, I'm good, I had two officers pull over some they had run down on a mother fucking...in the store and shit...the ... still out there you feel me...I still got the 150 for you..." MANASSE responded, "alright." Here, CLARK is explaining that some individuals were being questioned by police officers and that other police officers were in the area. CLARK indicated that he had \$150 for MANASSE and that he would provide that money to MANASSE later.

29. On March 5, 2011, at 4:09 p.m., in call number 3467, MANASSE received an incoming call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with PHILEMON PIERRE-SAINT. MANASSE stated, "hello, hello." PIERRE-SAINT replied, "yeah, hey bro, I'm gonna be calling you back like probably like in half an hour...I'm gonna need the rest of what I told you alright?" MANASSE responded, "alright, say no more." Here, PIERRE-SAINT was explaining to MANASSE that he needed more drugs and would be contacting MANASSE to arrange for MANASSE to supply him more drugs.

30. On March 7, 2011, at 9:57 a.m., in call number 3518, MANASSE received an incoming call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with DAVID GLASS, a/k/a "Grim/RU Grim" (hereinafter "GLASS"). GLASS stated, "yo, 'M-Easy'." Manasse responded, "what's good." GLASS replied, "umm, it's out here man." MANASSE responded, "I'm putting shit together now son." GLASS replied, "you hear what I said though, I want a full pack bro." MANASSE responded, "alright, alright, I got you." GLASS replied, "alright." MANASSE responded, "lots shit out there?" GLASS replied, "I'm the only one out here." Here, GLASS was explaining that he was the only person out on the street selling drugs and needed more from MANASSE. MANASSE indicated he was putting together some drugs for GLASS to sell.

31. On March 8, 2011, at 7:05 p.m., in call number 3803, MANASSE received an incoming call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with CHENETE PHILEMON, a/k/a "Jumanji" (hereinafter ("PHILEMON")). MANASSE stated, "hello...what's up?" PHILEMON replied, "the partner in 730 says he doesn't know what he needs...as long...he needs twenty because he doesn't know if thing is good, he is just taking five for now...and if it is good, he will talk to you again." MANASSE responded, "alright bro." Here, PHILEMON was explaining that an individual who MANASSE supplies drugs to wanted 5 grams of the new crack cocaine MANASSE had in order to test it out on customers and if the new crack cocaine was good, the individual would order 20 grams from MANASSE.

32. On March 9, 2011, at 10:52 a.m., in call number 3833, MANASSE received an incoming call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with AKMAD ANDERSON. MANASSE stated, "what's good?" ANDERSON replied, "this shit is in progress." MANASSE responded, "yeah...I'm about to go and grab that little" ANDERSON replied, "say no more...hey yo, you ain't get no buzz?" MANASSE responded, "nah, not yet, I'm still try to get some now...I got you." ANDERSON replied, "hit my phone when you get it." Here, ANDERSON was explaining to MANASSE that he was making drug sales. ANDERSON asked whether MANASSE had any more crack cocaine (i.e. "buzz"), which MANASSE indicated he was attempting to get more.

33. On March 10, 2011, at 12:04 p.m., in call number 4036, MANASSE made an outgoing call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with LEVELTSON GEORGES (hereinafter "GEORGES"). MANASSE stated, "how are those things...good?" GEORGES responded, "I see them, shit keep moving a little bit today." MANASSE replied, "you already finished them...the... he gave you, you finish them?" GEORGES responded, "no." MANASSE replied, "how

much money you already make?" GEORGES responded, "I think I make like 190?" MANASSE replied, "they asking for cook up?" GEORGES responded, "he gave me different bags." MANASSE replied, "they like it?" GEORGES responded, "yeah, what he gave me they like the red thing..." Here, MANASSE was asking GEORGES whether the drugs GEORGES was selling was of good quality and was selling in the streets. MANASSE further asked whether GEORGES had sold all of the drugs GEORGES had in his possession and how much money GEORGES had made thus far. MANASSE asked whether customers in the street were asking for "cook up," which is a street term for crack cocaine. GEORGES indicated that the customers liked the crack cocaine that was wrapped in red colored baggies.

34. On March 11, 2011, at 10:54 a.m., in call number 4297, MANASSE received an incoming call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with LEVELTSON GEORGES. GEORGES stated, "how much for 10 bags?" MANASSE responded, "for what, 'calot'?" GEORGES replied, "no, hum what you gave me before." MANASSE responded, "what dope?" GEORGES replied, "yeah." Here, GEORGES was asking MANASSE for more drugs and MANASSE responded by asking whether GEORGES wanted "dope", which is heroin. GEORGES then indicated that he wanted heroin.

35. On March 11, 2011, at 11:08 a.m., in call number 4307, MANASSE received an incoming call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with LEVELTSON GEORGES. GEORGES stated, "yo, I ain't going to lie to you that shit is moving fast as hell." MANASSE responded, "what the calot?" GEORGES replied, "yeah, both of them shit." MANASSE responded, "how much money you make already?" GEORGES replied, "I got \$350 already." MANASSE responded, "for the calot?" GEORGES replied, "yeah." MANASSE responded, "word...alright say no more, I'm going to get that shit, that shit is moving fast." GEORGES replied, "hell yeah, I told you..." Here, GEORGES explained that he was quickly selling the drugs MANASSE gave him earlier. GEORGES further explained that both the crack cocaine and heroin he had was selling fast and that he had already made \$350. MANASSE indicated that he would provide more drugs to GEORGES and for GEORGES to stay out on the street selling.

36. On March 11, 2011, at 1:31 p.m., in call number 4346, MANASSE received an incoming call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with TAFARY CLERVIL. CLERVIL stated, "I need to move...you want me to tell the guy you are not...you are not if he has something?" MANASSE replied, "hold on." CLERVIL responded, "alright...then let me tell you something, he has something on him right...but it's not cooked, he has 2-3 bags on him that are not cooked." MANASSE replied, "yes." CLERVIL

responded, "he says he has things on him for 40." MANASSE replied, "I don't understand, 2-3 things on him?" CLERVIL responded, "he has 2-3 bags...the bags have something that is not cooked, the thing is not cooked yet, so I asked him if he has something to sell but I will let you talk to him." MANASSE replied, "no...hell no, that's too much." Here, CLERVIL is explaining to MANASSE that there is an individual who has raw cocaine available that is not "cooked up" (i.e. it has not been cooked into crack cocaine). CLERVIL continued to explain to MANASSE that this individual had 2-3 bags of raw cocaine for sale but MANASSE indicated that was too much money for the product.

37. On March 11, 2011, at 7:14 p.m., in call number 4469, MANASSE made an outgoing call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with DONALD DUTERVAL (hereinafter "DUTERVAL"). MANASSE stated, "do you have money coming?" DUTERVAL replied, "yo is good...yeah, there will be money coming." MANASSE responded, "how much money you made so far?" DUTERVAL replied, "oh damn, I didn't even count it yet." MANASSE responded, "you by yourself?" DUTERVAL replied, "yeah, I'm by myself." MANASSE responded, "I'm gonna bring shit to you...how much money you make last night?" DUTERVAL replied, "I probably do like about \$400." MANASSE responded, "alright, alright." Here, MANASSE was asking whether DUTERVAL was selling drugs and how much money he had made. DUTERVAL indicated that he had made some money and he would be able to make more. DUTERVAL further indicated that he had made approximately \$400 the previous night and MANASSE explained that he was going to provide DUTERVAL with more drugs to sell.

38. On March 11, 2011, at 7:34 p.m., in call number 4504, MANASSE made an outgoing call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with AKMAD ANDERSON. MANASSE stated, "hit that ----- now son, I need some son..." ANDERSON replied, "I got you." MANASSE responded, "the other man good or he not good?" ANDERSON replied, "he good, he good." MANASSE responded, "alright, hit that ----- and tell that ----- like 40-50 son if he good son..." ANDERSON replied, "I got you bro." Here, MANASSE was asking whether ANDERSON had contacted his source of supply for crack cocaine because MANASSE need some and wanted to know whether it was of good quality. ANDERSON explained that his source of supply had good quality drugs, which MANASSE then asked for 40-50 grams of crack cocaine. ANDERSON indicated he would get the drugs for MANASSE.

39. On March 11, 2011, at 10:38 p.m., in call number 4593, MANASSE received an incoming call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with AKMAD ANDERSON. ANDERSON stated, "you gonna sell that shit by tomorrow?" MANASSE replied, "what you

say?" ANDERSON responded, "you gonna sell all that shit by tomorrow?" MANASSE replied, "what?" ANDERSON responded, "that white girl." MANASSE replied, "man I got 20 dollars left, I have to go and put it together for you tonight." ANDERSON responded, "yeah, because I'm getting ready to bag and shit, I wanted to pick some up but I wanted to see what you were gonna do and shit." MANASSE replied, "I'll holler at you about that shit...I got you son." Here, ANDERSON is asking whether MANASSE has cocaine (i.e. "white girl") because ANDERSON was getting ready to cook up some crack to bag and sell on the street. MANASSE explained that he needed to get more cocaine and that he would have it ready for ANDERSON later that night.

40. On March 12, 2011, at 11:06 a.m., in call number 4658, MANASSE made an outgoing call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with CHENETE PHILEMON. PHILEMON stated, "whats' good bro bro, you aint got nothing?" MANASSE replied, "that's right." PHILEMON responded, "yeah. I need something." MANASSE replied, "Fuck...I'm mad as hell." PHILEMON responded, "I'm in the crib, I ain't doing shit tonight." MANASSE replied, "...about to grab something." PHILEMON responded, "hey, you still got that though...?" MANASSE replied, "yeah, I still got it." PHILEMON responded, "I'll move that, I'll...just give me like...don't give me...we're not doing the whole thing again." MANASSE replied, "give you like what...a 3 bundle?" PHILEMON responded, "yeah, like that...I'm walking with that rice bag in my hand...they doing it good?" MANASSE replied, "yeah they moving it." Here, PHILEMON was asking whether MANASSE had any drugs because he needed some to sell. MANASSE indicated that he was going to get some for PHILEMON. PHILEMON explained that he would sell whatever MANASSE had available for him. MANASSE told PHILEMON he would give him some drugs to sell in a location where other drug dealers were selling drugs quickly.

41. On March 16, 2011, at 5:04 p.m., in call number 5366, MANASSE made an outgoing over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with LIGUNES BONNET, a/k/a "LB" (hereinafter "BONNET"). MANASSE stated, "what's good son?" BONNET replied, "yeah." MANASSE responded, "yo, you listening to me?...make sure you collect all the money from the ----- on the block son...you hear me?" BONNET replied, "yeah." MANASSE responded, "as soon as they get money, make sure you ask them for it and take it from them." BONNET replied, "yeah, I'm outside, I'm gonna give the ----- their shit now." Here, MANASSE was explaining to BONNET to make sure BONNET collected money from the individuals that sell drugs for MANASSE. BONNET indicated that he understood and would take care of collecting money for MANASSE.

42. On March 16, 2011, at 7:33 p.m., in call number 5463, MANASSE made an outgoing call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with ANQUAN CLARK. MANASSE stated, "where do you think 'LB' at?" CLARK replied, "I don't know, I'm on track right now, I'm getting all the bread, I don't know where the fuck he is at but I'm getting all the bread..." MANASSE responded, "you almost finished?" CLARK replied, "I got, I got like 70 for you, like 70 for you." MANASSE responded, "alright." Here, CLARK was explaining to MANASSE that he was making money selling drugs and was not sure where LIGUNES BONNET, a/k/a "LB" was to also sell drugs. CLARK further explained that he had made approximately \$70 and was still out in the street selling drugs.

43. On March 16, 2011, at 9:21 p.m., in call number 5526, MANASSE made an outgoing call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with CHENETE PHILEMON. MANASSE stated, "where are you now?" PHILEMON replied, "I'm on 14th." MANASSE responded, "how much you money you got on you?" PHILEMON replied, "I have not counted yet." MANASSE responded, "yo...call 'Ice'...call him now so he knows where you are man...we have to give someone something 200 man." PHILEMON replied, "I have it." MANASSE responded, "call 'Ice' now so he can know, please man...call him now." PHILEMON replied, "alright." Here, MANASSE was asking how much money PHILEMON made from drug sales because MANASSE needed to pay someone \$200. MANASSE directed PHILEMON to contact BRADNEY MANASSE, a/k/a "Ice" to advise B. MANASSE that PHILEMON had the money.

44. On March 16, 2011, at 11:18 p.m., in call number 5546, MANASSE made an outgoing call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with CHENETE PHILEMON. MANASSE stated, "you still out there?" PHILEMON replied, "yeah." MANASSE responded, "how many have you done so far?" PHILEMON replied, "I have 150." Here, MANASSE was asking how much money PHILEMON had made from selling drugs, which PHILEMON indicated \$150.

45. On March 17, 2011, at 6:39 p.m., in call number 5633, MANASSE received an incoming call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with LIGUNES BONNET. BONNET stated, "I'm finished bro." MANASSE replied, "how much you have?" BONNET responded, "150." MANASSE replied, "alright, hold that shit, I'm gonna come and get it, just hold it, I'm gonna come and get it right now." Here, BONNET was explaining that he had sold all the drugs MANASSE had provided him and made \$150. MANASSE indicated that he would get the money from BONNET later.

46. On March 17, 2011, at 10:25 p.m., in call number 5593, MANASSE made an outgoing call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY

and spoke with ANQUAN CLARK. MANASSE stated, "what's good, you alright?" CLARK replied, "yeah, I'm good big bro, I'm out here man this shit slow but I'm out here fucking...you heard." MANASSE responded, "stay out there...the shit gonna pick back up you feel me? We are getting 'Grim' back." CLARK replied, "alright...I'm the only one fucking outside." Here, CLARK is explaining to MANASSE that he is not making any drug sales and things are slow. MANASSE indicated that DAVID GLASS, a/k/a "Grim" would be coming to sell drugs and assist CLARK and that sales would pick up.

47. On March 19, 2011, at 11:29 a.m., in call number 5784, MANASSE made an outgoing call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with DONALD DUTERVAL. MANASSE stated, "yo, what's good son?" DUTERVAL replied, "I'm good." MANASSE responded, "things are moving out there?" DUTERVAL replied, "I just got here, things are beginning to move." MANASSE responded, "alright, alright, you good?" Here, MANASSE was asking whether DUTERVAL was selling drugs, DUTERVAL indicated that things were "beginning to move" meaning customers were starting to buy drugs and he was making some sales.

48. On March 20, 2011, at 7:19 p.m., in call number 5925, MANASSE received an incoming call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with LIGUNES BONNET. BONNET stated, "yeah, what's good bro?" MANASSE replied, "you finished?" BONNET responded, "yeah, I'm finished." MANASSE replied, "how much bread you got?" BONNET responded, "I have \$150 for you." MANASSE replied, "alright, get that, alright, I'm about to come through there." BONNET responded, "yo 'Birdy' is here with me, you want me to give him the money for you?" MANASSE replied, "I'm about to get it, I'm about to get cause I got to get the money from what's her name to." BONNET responded, "alright, I have nothing man." MANASSE replied, "alright, I got some I'm putting together now." Here, MANASSE was asking whether BONNET was finished selling the drugs MANASSE had provided him. BONNET indicated that he had \$150 for MANASSE and asked whether he should give it to TAFARY CLERVIL, a/k/a "Birdy" who was with BONNET. MANASSE told BONNET that he would be coming down to pick up the money. BONNET explained that he had no more drugs to sell, which MANASSE acknowledged and said that he would provide BONNET with more drugs when he saw him again.

49. On March 21, 2011, at 8:08 p.m., in call number 6019, MANASSE received an incoming call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with ANQUAN CLARK. CLARK stated, "where you at, where you at?" MANASSE replied, "I'm about to come and get it." CLARK responded, "word, hey yo, this shit is looking crazy,

all the shit coming like crazy...you heard...I had just counted 'LB' shit and I counted my shit and it's 400...you heard?" MANASSE replied, "alright." Here, CLARK is explaining to MANASSE that he and LIGUNES BONNET, a/k/a "LB" were making a lot of money selling drugs and had already made approximately \$400 for MANASSE.

50. On March 23, 2011, at 9:19 p.m., in call number 6298, MANASSE received an incoming call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with DONALD DUTERVAL. DUTERVAL stated, "yo, yo, uhm, 'Pop' came to get the money." MANASSE replied, "huh?" DUTERVAL responded, "I said, 'Pop' came to get the money...he probably gonna give it to you." MANASSE replied, "what money?" DUTERVAL responded, "the coke money." MANASSE replied, "get my money back from him son...don't give my money to those people, I don't give my money to nobody, no money, you hear me?" DUTERVAL responded, "yes." MANASSE replied, "when it comes to my things...don't give anybody my money son, hold that shit." DUTERVAL responded, "yeah, because he got about like \$290." MANASSE replied, "alright...say no more." Here, DUTERVAL explained to MANASSE that he gave AKMAD ANDERSON, a/k/a "Pop" the money he made from selling MANASSE's drugs. MANASSE was frustrated and explained that DUTERVAL should not give his money to anyone other than MANASSE himself. DUTERVAL acknowledged that he understood and told MANASSE that "Pop" had approximately \$290 that DUTERVAL gave to him.

51. On March 24, 2011, at 8:45 p.m., in call number 6394, MANASSE made an outgoing call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with DONALD DUTERVAL. MANASSE stated, "whats' good you, where you at son?" DUTERVAL replied, "I went back over there and shit." MANASSE responded, "alright, you there?" DUTERVAL replied, "yeah, yeah." MANASSE responded, "you making money?" DUTERVAL replied, "yeah, it's coming a little bit." MANASSE responded, "how much money did you already make on the thing?" DUTERVAL replied, "like 140, 150." MANASSE responded, "that's what you made so far or that's the shit you got already?" DUTERVAL replied, "that's the shit I got already." Here, MANASSE was asking whether DUTERVAL was selling drugs for MANASSE and how much money DUTERVAL had made. DUTERVAL indicated that he had already made approximately \$150.

52. On March 25, 2011, at 5:28 p.m., in call number 6517, MANASSE received an incoming call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with LIGUNES BONNET. BONNET stated, "I have the remainder of the 200 for you..." MANASSE replied, "so how much to you have?" BONNET responded, "to finish?" MANASSE replied, "huh?" BONNET responded, "what I had is finished

already." MANASSE replied, "you don't have anything more?" BONNET responded, "yeah, I have only one packet left, I gave 'GS' one and I kept the other one." MANASSE replied, "alright." Here, BONNET was explaining he had \$200 for MANASSE for drugs he sold. BONNET further explained that he was finished with the drugs that MANASSE had provided him and that he had one left because he gave the other to ANQUAN CLARK, a/k/a "GS" to sell.

53. On March 25, 2011, at 10:55 p.m., in call number 6549, MANASSE received an incoming call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with DONALD DUTERVAL. MANASSE stated, "what's going on...you don't call me at all?" DUTERVAL replied, "because I haven't got a chance to start on your shit yet." MANASSE responded, "you are still working on that guy's things?...you should have did something on my shit too...fuck that guy man...start working on my things too man." DUTERVAL replied, "yeah, I'm about...I'm about to do that now cause his shit is almost about to be done anyway." MANASSE responded, "how much...how many have you done for him anyway?" DUTERVAL replied, "like around \$300." MANASSE responded, "alright, start working on my things to man...you got to go half-half." Here, MANASSE was asking whether DUTERVAL had sold any of MANASSE's drugs. DUTERVAL indicated that he had not yet begun selling MANASSE's drugs because he was finishing selling another individuals drugs. MANASSE was frustrated and told DUTERVAL to start selling MANASSE's drugs.

54. On March 31, 2011, at 1:26 p.m. in call number 7242, MANASSE made an outgoing call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with LIGUNES BONNET. BONNET stated, "hey, what's good bro...I was calling you man because a lot of people out there need stuff man." MANASSE replied, "you have not spoken to 'Ice'?" BONNET responded, "he doesn't answer." MANASSE replied, "alright, I'm about to come now." BONNET responded, "alright." Here, BONNET advised MANASSE that he had no drugs to sell and that customers out in the street were looking to purchase drugs. MANASSE asked whether BONNET had contacted BRADNEY MANASSE, a/k/a "Ice", which BONNET indicated he had but that BRADNEY MANASSE was not answering his phone. The conversation concluded with MANASSE explaining that he would be down to see BONNET and presumably provide him drugs to sell.

55. On March 31, 2011, at 8:03 p.m., in call number 7298, MANASSE made an outgoing call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with ISRAEL PETIOTE, a/k/a "Little Easy" (hereinafter "PETIOTE"). MANASSE stated, "yeah, you are not coming buzzin?" PETIOTE replied, "yeah, I'm about to hook up at 'Rims' house." MANASSE responded, "alright, go right now, hurry up, I'm about to

pull up over there son." PETIOTE replied, "alright." Here, MANASSE was asking whether PETIOTE was going to be out selling drugs. PETIOTE indicated that he was on his way to JOVANY CLERMONT's a/k/a "Rims" house to get some drugs.

56. On April 1, 2011, at 3:07 p.m., in call number 7419, MANASSE received an incoming call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with ISRAEL PETIOTE. PETIOTE stated, "yeah, yeah, you ain't bust that move yet?" MANASSE replied, "no, I ain't do that yet...it's gonna be today though, I'm waiting right now, I'm just waiting and shit, because I got lots of shit I got to do man." PETIOTE responded, "ok, because that ----- blow my phone...they need that down there and shit...you hear me?" Here, PETIOTE is asking whether MANASSE received any drugs from his source of supply because PETIOTE has customers who are waiting to purchase drugs. MANASSE explained that he was waiting for his source of supply to call him back and that he also had customers waiting to purchase drugs.

57. On April 2, 2011 at 11:16 a.m., in call number 7522, MANASSE received an incoming call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with DAVID GLASS. GLASS stated, "yo! I finished that set you want...yo." MANASSE replied, "yeah." GLASS responded, "I got a hundred...I got a hundred...I gave you a hundred earlier before." MANASSE replied, "alright." GLASS replied, "yeah, when you gonna have some more?" MANASSE replied, "tomorrow." Here, GLASS is explaining how he sold all the drugs MANASSE had supplied him and that GLASS had one hundred dollars to give to MANASSE. GLASS asked when MANASSE would have additional drugs available for GLASS to sell, which MANASSE indicated he would have the next day.

58. On April 2, 2011, at 9:44 p.m., in call number 7532, MANASSE received an incoming call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with THIMOTE "TIM" PIERCIN (hereinafter "PIERCIN"). MANASSE stated, "yo! What's is going on?" PIERCIN replied, "yo, the man didn't call me yesterday, and you're already calling...text me...I'm gonna call him...he told me it's today, the deal couldn't be done yesterday...you're already text me, as if I have something...as soon as the thing comes, I will call man." MANASSE responded, "alright." PIERCIN replied, "as soon that I have it, you know, I have you man." MANASSE replied, "alright." PIERCIN is an individual who sometimes supplies MANASSE with drugs. Here, MANASSE was discussing with PIERCIN when PIERCIN was going to obtain more drugs. PIERCIN explained that he was waiting for his source of supply to get more drugs and when that happened PIERCIN would contact MANASSE and get him more drugs.

59. On April 2, 2011, at 1:01 p.m., in call number 7553, MANASSE received an incoming call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with DAVID GLASS. GLASS stated, "yo, I got umm, I got one hundred for the other pack and 150 for the..." MANASSE replied, "alright, when you done, just hit me man, cause I ain't...you feel me. I'm shopping for my store man...this shit, I don't even know if I'm gonna have some later man, you heard?" GLASS responded, "you don't know if you gonna have none?" MANASSE replied, "hell no son! I'm mad as hell man." GLASS responded, "this shit clocking man...there's a lot of money out there son." MANASSE replied, "it ain't my fault son...it ain't me." GLASS responded, "I know, I know bro." MANASSE replied, "alright son." GLASS responded, "I'm gonna hit you when I'm finished." MANASSE replied, "alright." Here, GLASS is explaining to MANASSE how much money he made from selling drugs. MANASSE told GLASS to contact him when GLASS was done selling the drugs. MANASSE further explained that he was uncertain whether he would have more drugs for GLASS to sell because his source of supply did not yet contact him. GLASS was frustrated by this news and advised MANASSE that there were many customers out in the street looking to purchase drugs and that if they had no drugs to sell he and MANASSE were going to lose money. The conversation concluded with MANASSE indicating that he would contact GLASS as soon as he had more drugs.

60. On April 3, 2011, at 11:58 a.m., in call number 7746, MANASSE made an outgoing call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with THIMOTE "TIM" PIERCIN. PIERCIN stated, "the guy told the thing has not come yet...I spoke to him not too long ago." MANASSE replied, "damn seems he is lying man." PIERCIN responded, "even me, I have nothing to sell...not even garbage, I'm waiting for him man." MANASSE replied, "I took something from a partner that has a garbage I asked him for 60 he scared, he gave me only 20 it was hard man." PIERCIN responded, "it wasn't good?" MANASSE replied, "no, you when that thing is not good, if you throw it you will lose so I just..." PIERCIN responded, "you did not take any?" MANASSE replied, "yes, I took it." PIERCIN responded, "what you do with it?" MANASSE replied, "I turned into 23." Here, PIERCIN is explaining to MANASSE that his source of supply has still not provided him any drugs. MANASSE explained that he ended up getting 20 grams of crack cocaine from another individual but that the quality was poor (i.e. "garbage"). MANASSE further explained that he turned the 20 grams into 23 grams, by adding another substance such as baking soda or other cutting agent that is commonly used by narcotics dealers.

61. On April 4, 2011, at 4:37 p.m., in call number 7956, MANASSE made an outgoing call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with THIMOTE "TIM" PIERCIN. PIERCIN stated, "what's up? MANASSE replied, "yo, what's good." PIERCIN responded, "yeah, he said he will do it by...that shit is gonna happen by 6:30." MANASSE replied, "6:30? Why so late?" PIERCIN responded, "I'm saying they're still waiting for that shit to hit...around this time, though...that's what he said." MANASSE replied, "a slice we need now, we need a half man...we wanted 500...you're playing man?" PIERCIN responded, "I don't...the shit will happen around this time." Here, PIERCIN was explaining to MANASSE that his source of supply was going to provide him drugs at 6:30 that evening and that once he got it he would contact MANASSE. MANASSE indicated that he needed 500, meaning 500 grams of cocaine.

62. On April 5, 2011, at 1:58 p.m., in call number 7407, MANASSE made an outgoing call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with LEVELTSON GEORGES. MANASSE stated, "yeah, you haven't done anything yet?" GEORGES replied, "no, I'll call you when I'm finished to give you the money." MANASSE responded, "how much money did you already make?" GEORGES replied, "I haven't counted it yet..." MANASSE responded, "alright then call me back." Here, MANASSE was asking how much drugs GEORGES had sold and GEORGES indicated that he was not yet finished selling all the drugs he had. MANASSE asked how much GEORGES had already made, which GEORGES was unsure about and said that he would call MANASSE later.

63. On April 5, 2011, at 4:21 p.m., in call number 7435, MANASSE received an incoming call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with LEVELTSON GEORGES. MANASSE stated, "what's good bro?" GEORGES replied, "I'm done with the white candy..." MANASSE responded, "how much you got?" GEORGES replied, "\$300." MANASSE responded, "alright, I'm about to come through." Here, GEORGES was explaining to MANASSE that he finished selling the crack cocaine (i.e. "white candy") and that he made \$300. MANASSE advised that he would be coming by to collect the money.

64. On April 5, 2011, at 1:38 p.m., in call number 8050, MANASSE received an incoming call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with LEVELTSON GEORGES. MANASSE stated, "you're good man?" GEORGES replied, "I'm good, what's up dawg?" MANASSE responded, "I got you son, I got you. I'm gonna find something today." GEORGES replied, "there is no more cookies, I'm left with only bottles...I'm left with only two bottles since yesterday." MANASSE responded, "how much money you have?"

GEORGES replied, "didn't I give you the money yesterday?" MANASSE responded, "alright, alright, what about the 'calot'?" GEORGES replied, "the 'calot' I have not moved it yet because they don't want to take that shit." MANASSE responded, "oh man...alright, I'm gonna call you back." Here, GEORGES is explaining how much product he has left and how he needs more. MANASSE asked whether GEORGES sold any of the "calot" (i.e. crack cocaine), which GEORGES indicated he had not because the customers in the street did not like the quality. The conversation concluded with MANASSE explaining that he would call GEORGES later.

65. On April 5, 2011, at 9:52 p.m., in call number 8238, MANASSE received an incoming call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with TAFARY CLERVIL. MANASSE stated, "what's good?" CLERVIL replied, "done with that...it came out to 1360." MANASSE responded, "God damn son, you is a waste of time bro...word is bond son...yo take 200 man and put the rest in bags you heard me?" CLERVIL replied, "yeah and do what?" MANASSE responded, "take 200 for yourself...do packs and give them, give them...just hold on to them yourself and give them to 'Grim' later." CLERVIL replied, "280." MANASSE responded, "I said take 200 for yourself." CLERVIL replied, "alright." Here, CLERVIL was explaining that he had 1,360 bags of drugs to sell for MANASSE. MANASSE told CLERVIL to take 200 bags for to sell and give rest of the bags to DAVID GLASS, a/k/a "Grim" to sell.

66. On April 6, 2011, at 12:58 p.m., in call number 8395, MANASSE received an incoming call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with THIMOTE "TIM" PIERCIN. PIERCIN stated, "you good, you get something?" MANASSE replied, "hell yeah, I went to New York man." PIERCIN responded, "alright, I just talked with the guy, he said tomorrow afternoon, he will be good." MANASSE replied, "when tomorrow afternoon." PIERCIN responded, "tomorrow afternoon, he just called me right now I was in a program when he called to tell me he is going to be good tomorrow." MANASSE replied, "alright, tell him to contact me if it's good." Here, PIERCIN was asking whether MANASSE was able to find drugs from another source of supply since PIERCIN's source of supply had not yet provided PIERCIN drugs. MANASSE explained that he purchased narcotics from a source in New York city. PIERCIN advised MANASSE that his source of supply was going to have drugs the following day, which MANASSE acknowledged and told PIERCIN to contact him if that happened.

67. On April 7, 2011, at 9:14 p.m., in call number 8547, MANASSE made an outgoing call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with ISRAEL PETIOTE. MANASSE stated, "I have the thing

now." PETIOTE replied, "you took it for me?" MANASSE responded, "yeah, I got you...you coming to pick me up at the hospital or what because I want to give you something." PETIOTE replied, "yeah, I'll come for it." MANASSE responded, "how are you going to do it? You have to get someone that can sell there so you can make some money man while you are in jail you feel me...get someone that can sell for you because you messed up with the PD man...so while you are in there I can give him merchandise and let someone in charge of your money man." Here, MANASSE is explaining that he has drugs to give to PETIOTE, which PETIOTE indicated he would come and pick up from MANASSE. MANASSE further explained how PETIOTE needed to have someone sell drugs and collect money for PETIOTE if PETIOTE ever went to jail for any extended period of time.

68. On April 8, 2011, at 11:40 p.m., in call number 8804, MANASSE received an incoming call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with DAVID GLASS. GLASS stated, "hey bro, I got 180 for you...100 from 'GS', 80 from me...you heard?" MANASSE replied, "say that again?" GLASS responded, "I said, I got 180 for you right now...I got 180...100 from 'GS', 80 from me..." MANASSE replied, "how much you got all together?" GLASS responded, "180, I gave 'ICE' 50, you heard me?" Here, GLASS is explaining to MANASSE that he has \$180 to give to MANASSE for drugs he and ANQUAN CLARK, a/k/a "GS" sold. Glass further explained that he gave \$50 to "ICE" who is BRADNEY MANASSE.

69. On April 9, 2011, at 5:17 p.m., in call number 8865, MANASSE received an incoming call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with ISRAEL PETIOTE. MANASSE stated, "I'm going to get something right now." PETIOTE replied, "I thought you have it yesterday." MANASSE responded, "I didn't get man...you know how things flip flop you have to be in an area dog..." PETIOTE replied, "when you getting it...now?" MANASSE responded, "I'm getting it now." PETIOTE replied, "alright, that shit is going to go son, I'm telling you." Here, MANASSE is explaining that he is going to pick up some drugs to give to PETIOTE because he did not get any the day before. PETIOTE indicated that he was going to be able to sell the drugs quickly because customers were asking for product.

70. In addition to distributing drugs in and around Essex County, New Jersey, this criminal street gang is responsible for committing and/or attempting to commit acts of violence. On or about January 5, 2011, in a recorded conversation, MANASSE contacted CS for the purpose of having CS murder an individual. Law enforcement reviewed the contents of the conversation in which MANASSE is discussing and orchestrating a plan to get CS to

lure the individual out of his home in order for MANASSE to shoot the individual. After receiving this information, law enforcement was able to identify the individual and prevent the shooting from occurring. Several months later, during the course of monitoring the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY, law enforcement intercepted another instance where MANASSE order the murder of an individual. On or about April 1, 2011, at 3:01 p.m., in call number 7417, MANASSE made an outgoing call over the SECOND MANASSE FACILITY and spoke with CHENETE PHILEMON. MANASSE stated, "where you ----- at?" PHILEMON responded, "we have to go pick up what's his name? We have to go pick up...Louie have to pick up little...from school." MANASSE replied, "what's up son, you ain't gonna do that son?" PHILEMON responded, "yeah, I'm gonna do that...I'm on my way over there right now." Here, MANASSE is asking whether PHILEMON is going to shoot an individual that MANASSE wants murdered. PHILEMON indicated that he was going to do it and that he was on his way. MANASSE replied, "'Ice'...just hell man." PHILEMON responded, "tell 'Ice' man stop playing with me man." MANASSE replied, "yo man, 'Ice' said get the weapon." PHILEMON responded, "no, no, tell 'Ice' to shut up man." MANASSE replied [aside], "he tells you to shut up man...tell 'Bamby' what it is that's to start to go down too." PHILEMON responded, "alright, 'Bamby' already knows, that's where we're getting ready to go right now." Here, MANASSE told PHILEMON that Bradney Manasse a/k/a "Ice" said for PHILEMON to make sure he has a weapon to commit the murder. PHILEMON recognizing that MANASSE and B. MANASSE are making fun of him for not knowing how to murder an individual told them both to shut up. MANASSE told PHILEMON to make sure an individual by the name of "Bamby" knew about the plan, PHILEMON indicated that "Bamby" knew about it and was on his way to get "Bamby." MANASSE replied, "alright, tell him to park somewhere so you can know exactly where to run man." PHILEMON responded, "alright." MANASSE replied, "and flip the shit man, alright." PHILEMON responded, "alright." MANASSE replied, "he out there, just flip the shit man, you have something to cover your head with right?" PHILEMON responded, "yeah, I got that already." MANASSE replied, "alright, walk and pretend you...you feel me...with your head down and shit man." PHILEMON responded, "alright." MANASSE replied, "don't go through his pockets man." PHILEMON responded, "alright." MANASSE replied, "don't even touch him." PHILEMON responded, "alright." Here, MANASSE is directing PHILEMON to murder the unidentified individual and to make sure PHILEMON is in a position where he is able to quickly escape the area once he shoots the intended victim. MANASSE explains that PHILEMON should make sure he wears a mask when he does the shooting and to make sure not to touch the intended victim or try to take anything off the victim after he shoots him. Based on this

conversation, law enforcement sought and were able to locate PHILEMON in order to prevent him from committing the homicide. Although PHILEMON had no firearm on his person, he was in possession of a dark colored ski mask.
