
The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

From in or about September, 2009, to on or about February 18, 2010, in Hudson County, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, the defendant,

MICHAEL J. STERNQUIST,  
a/k/a "John Torchwood,"

did knowingly produce, transfer and possess one or more document-making implements and authentication features, with the intent that such document-making implements and authentication features be used in the production of a false identification document and another document-making implement and false identification feature, such production, transfer, and possession in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce, and such offense having been committed after a prior conviction under Title 18, United States Code, Section 1028 became final.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 1028(a)(5) and 1028(b)(3)(C), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.
