SECOND AMENDED INFORMATION

The United States Charges:

On or between December 3, 2003, and August 16, 2004, in Bernalillo County, and elsewhere within the District of New Mexico, the Defendant, **FIDEL R. GARZA**, then president of American Federation of Government Employees (AFGE) AFL-CIO Local Union (LU) 2063, a labor union covered by the Civil Service Reform Act of 1978 (CSRA), devised and intended to devise a scheme and artifice to defraud the members of LU 2063 and for the purpose of executing the scheme and artifice to defraud, the Defendant, **FIDEL R. GARZA**, knowingly transmitted and caused to be transmitted by means of wire communication in interstate commerce certain signs, signals, and sounds, by fraudulently using LU 2063's debit cards No. 000154901045, No. 4635860000141897 and No. 4635860000141889, for debit card purchases and cash advances for his unlawful personal use in the approximate amount of \$20,625.22,

contrary to LU 2063 purposes and contrary to authorization as described for the president of LU 2063.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1343.
